Energy was high, pickups were on top of each other, all of the jokes were landing, and the show was an absolute hit with the audience. The kids truly went all-out with this performance. It was also one of our best technical runs. No light or fly cues were missed, late, or early, and all sound cues were called correctly. Aside from the crash SFX being called, it was a near-perfect show. We also had an incident with the dummy. When bringing the Robbin' Hood drop out, the dummy got caught. Despite our fly crew being absolute troopers- running up into the catwalks, bringing the drop in at every opportunity to release the dummy, and attempt every possible idea to release this prop- it would not budge, and we did the end of act one without the dummy involved in the sequence. The Cast picked up pretty quickly (thanks primarily to Keegan and Isabel for picking it up) and reacted to try to inform the audience of what was happening without the prop. We adjusted the Entre' Acte to include a short dummy sequence to keep the integrity of the show, and it seemed to have filled the hole that the dummy left at the end of act one. Act two had a rocky start in terms of lines and lyrics, but the kids picked it back up and maintained energy all the way through. They got a well-deserved standing ovation and the show was a wrap. There were two very prominent issues, but aside from those, this run was an absolute success!

- The first crash SFX was executed correctly.

Issues/Repairs

- The dummy got caught on the Robbin' Hood drop as the drop came out today. Despite the best efforts of the backstage crew (who were absolutely fantastic) and myself, we were unable to get it loose during the show. This resulted in the dummy not being present at the end of act one. We adjusted and improvised a cue sequence at the top of act two during the Entre'Acte, where the main was brought up and the dummy was hanging with a follow spot on it. This kept the integrity of the story and was the best solution we could come up with.
- We're going to try leaving the dummy on the line set it was hanging on during the Entre'Acte today during tomorrow's show so there is less chance of the dummy getting caught again.
- Lines and lyrics were all over the place for the top of act two up until the end of "It's A Business."
- There were two out of place crash SFX repetitions after the correct call.
