THE FOLLOWING IS A CHECKLIST OF REQUIRED ITEMS TO BE SUBMITTED WITH THIS APPLICATION. ONLY COMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR FUNDING.

\_\_\_ Application-complete online at [www.easternshoshoneeducation.com](http://www.easternshoshoneeducation.com).

\_\_\_ Agreement, Release of Information, Privacy Statement and Financial Needs Analysis; documents will be emailed to the student or the student may download the documents from the website and fill them out and return the documents to our office.

\_\_\_ All student must apply for the **Free Application For Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** no later than six (6) weeks prior to the first day of class, regardless of whether they qualify or not. It can be accessed and submitted online at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). The FAFSA will determine if you are eligible for a Pell grant or work study. You may complete the FAFSA as early as October 1<sup>st</sup>.

✓ Our office requires the confirmation page that shows the student had applied successfully.

\_\_\_ Complete the top portion of the **Financial Needs Analysis** form and submit it to the college Financial Aid Office that you are attending. The bottom portion must be completed by the school Financial Aid Officer **NOT** the student.

\_\_\_ New students must submit a **Letter of Acceptance** from the school they are planning to attend. If a continuing student changes schools they must submit a new letter of acceptance from the new school.

\_\_\_ Detailed **Schedule of the Courses**; must show number of credits, dates, locations and times.

\_\_\_ Copy of **Program of Study** which includes General Requirements, Program Requirements and Program Electives.

\_\_\_ Formal **Personal Letter** requesting funding from the tribe. The letter **MUST BE TYPED** and should include your major plan of study, goals, plans after leaving school and intended date of graduation.

\_\_\_ Copy of **High School Diploma, GED Certificate or Transcripts** from school last attended.

\_\_\_ Copy of **Picture Identification**.

\_\_\_ **Certificate of Indian Blood (CIB)** from the Shoshone Enrollment Office. They can be contacted at (307) 332-3908.

**\*\*\*NOTE\*\*\***

All complete applications are assigned a priority the date they are received in the office. Students are cautioned that although they have completed and submitted the application before the deadline there may be additional information required before a scholarship can be awarded.

**Students will need to contact the Education Program to check the status of their application and to ensure all necessary documents have been received by the deadline.**
