Horse Powered Reading

Horse powered reading is a full body experience!
Students interact with horses from the ground, while using toys and props to develop reading skills. Led by Kellie Bogardus, certified teacher and Horse Powered Reading & Math Facilitator.

Cost per session is \$50 and scholarships are available.

During sessions, students are given the opportunity to:

- Improve understanding by identifying stumbling blocks.
- Experience movement while learning, which anchors memory retention and recall.
- Connect with horses, volunteers, and other learners which allows for new social relationships
- Reflect on what they are experiencing to create new patterns of learning.

Horse Powered Reading Goals:

- Build phonetic awareness and word recognition
- Overcome barriers that block comprehension
- Use critical and creative thinking

- Learn new, unfamiliar, and multisyllable words
- Develop and practice study skills
- Enhance vocabulary
