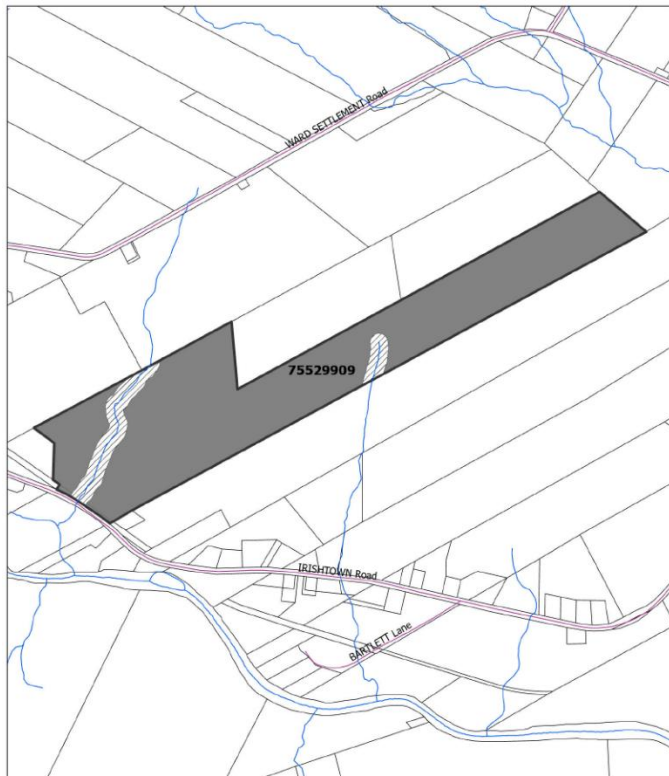


Notice of Public Hearing
