THIRTY SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Jeremiah 31:7-9

Jeremiah speaks of God reuniting the people of Israel after their exile. He states that although they departed in tears, God will lead them all back and protect them, because he is father to Israel

Second Reading: Hebrews 5:1-6

Each high priest is taken from among people and offers sacrifices for their sins. High priests do not choose to take on this honor, but are chosen by God. Even Christ did not choose this office, but was chosen by God to be a priest forever.

Gospel: Mark 10:46-52

A blind beggar approached Jesus and pleaded that Jesus heal him. Jesus called the man over and said, "Your faith has healed you." The man immediately received his sight and proceeded to follow Jesus up the road.

Primera Lectura: Jeremías 31:7-9

Jeremías habla de que Dios reunirá al pueblo de Israel después de su exilio. Declara que a pesar de que salieron llenos de lágrimas, Dios los guiará de regreso y los protegerá, pues El es Padre de Israel.

Segunda Lectura: Hebreos 5:1-6

Se escoge a cada gran sacerdote de entre la gente y ofrece sacrificios por sus pecados. Los grandes sacerdotes no escogen este honor, sino son escogidos por Dios. Aún Cristo no escogió este oficio, sino fué escogido por Dios a ser sacerdote por siempre.

Evangelió: San Marcos 10:46-52

Un pordiosero ciego se acercó a Jesús y le suplicó que lo curara. Jesús pidió al hombre que se acercara y le dijo: "Por tu fé has sido sanado". El hombre inmediatamente recibió su vista y procedió a seguir a Jesús por el camino.

Jesus, Son of David, have pity on me.' ... 'Take courage, get up, Jesus is calling you'. Jesus said to him in reply, 'What do you want me to do for you?' The blind man replied to him, 'Master, I want to see.' Jesus told him, 'Go your way, your faith has saved you.'"

It is easy for us to rapidly pass by someone in need, asking for a coin to get something to eat, assisting a blind person to cross the street, to lend a hand to an elderly person in need. What if Bartimaeus the beggar did not continue to cry out. Jesus heard, listened, asked, and then reassured him, and his sight was restored because of his faith.

Jesus asks what can He do for us. May we ask Him to remove our blindness, assist someone in need, continue to be faithful in prayer, calling out to Him. Open our eyes to see the potential I have to assist someone else.

Jesús, ¡Hijo de David, ten piedad de mí!... Entonces llamaron al ciego y le dijeron: '¡Animo, levántate! El te llama'... Jesús le preguntó: '¿Qué quieres que haga por ti?'... El le respondió: 'Maestro, que yo pueda ver'. Jesús le dijo: 'Vete, tu fe te ha salvado'".

Es fácil para nosotros pasar con prisa al lado de alguien que pide una moneda para comer, ayudar a una persona ciega a cruzar la calle, darle una mano a un anciano necesitado. ¿Qué hubiera pasado si Bartimeo, el mendigo, no hubiera seguido gritando? Jesús lo escuchó, luego lo calmó y su vista fue restaurada por su fe.

Jesús pregunta qué puede hacer por nosotros. Por qué no pedirle que nos devuelva la vista, que podamos ayudar a un necesitado, tener fe al orar, llamándolo a El. Abramos nuestros ojos para ver el potencial que tenemos de ayudar a alguien más.
