A Word From the Gospel

“Indeed, the word of God is living and effective, sharper than any two edged sword, penetrating even between soul and spirit, joints and marrow, and able to discern reflections and thoughts of the heart... ‘Good teacher , what must I do to inherit eternal life?’”

We take a minute to read this reflection, we hear the word of God proclaimed at mass, we spend some time every week, reading the Bible at home. Before opening the text, as we are seated at mass, or even at this moment, consider saying ‘speak Lord, your servant is listening’. This moment of focus will allow the word from Hebrews and the question from Mark to penetrate our hearts and allow us to discern what the Lord is asking of us and lead us in our journey to eternal life.

‘Go, sell what you have and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven, then come, follow me. waiting for you.

Nos tomamos un minuto para leer esta reflexión, escuchamos la palabra de Dios siendo proclamada durante la misa, pasamos algún tiempo cada semana leyendo la biblia en casa. Antes de abrir el texto, al sentarnos durante la misa, o aún en este momento, considere decir ‘habla, Señor, tu siervo escucha’. Este momento de enfoque permitirá a la palabra de Hebreos y a la pregunta de San Marcos penetrar en nuestros corazones y permitirnos discernir lo que el Señor nos pide y que nos guíe en nuestra jornada a la vida eterna.

‘Vende todo lo que tienes y distribúyelo entre los pobres, y tendrás un tesoro en el cielo. Después ven y sígueme. sea bendecido en la iglesia. El Señor los está esperando.

First Reading: Wisdom 7:7-11

This poem discusses how the spirit of wisdom is far more beautiful than any riches could be. All gold is no more than sand when compared to the importance of wisdom, which often leads people to the other good things in life.

Second Reading: Hebrews 4:12-13

God's perception of people is called "sharper than any two-edged sword." God is able to know the thoughts and feelings of all his people. We can hide nothing from him, and will need to account for all he has seen in us.

Gospel: Mark 10:17-30

A man asks Jesus how he can share in everlasting life. Jesus tells him to sell his possessions and travel with them. The man refuses and Jesus tells his disciples how difficult it is for a rich person to enter heaven if they are too concerned with their possessions. The disciples remind Jesus that they gave up everything for him, but he assures them they will be rewarded with everlasting life.

Primera Lectura: Sabiduría 7:7-11

Este poema dice que el espíritu de sabiduría es mucho más bello que cualquier cantidad de riquezas. Todo el oro no es más que arena comparado con la importancia de la sabiduría, que a menudo dirige a la gente a otras cosas buenas en la vida.

Segunda Lectura: Hebreos 4:12-13

La percepción que Dios tiene de la gente es "más aguda que cualquier espada de dos filos". Dios es capaz de conocer los pensamientos y sentimientos de toda su gente. No podemos esconder nada a El, y debemos dar cuenta de todo lo que ha visto en nosotros.

Evangelio: San Marcos 10:17-30

Un hombre le pregunta a Jesús cómo alcanzar la vida eterna. Jesús le dice que venda sus posesiones y viaje con El. El hombre rehusa y Jesús dice a sus discípulos que es muy difícil que un hombre rico entre en el cielo si está tan preocupado de sus bienes. Los discípulos le recuerdan a Jesús que ellos dieron todo por El. Jesús les asegura que serán recompensados con vida eterna.
