TWENTY-FOURTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY

First Reading: Wisdom 2:12, 17-20

Wicked people discuss their anger at the just one, because they do not like being reproached for their evil ways. They want to see if he is the Son of God, so they decide to torture him and see if God will come to defend him. They decide to condemn him to a shameful death and see if the claims are true that God will take care of him.

Second Reading: James 3:16—4:3

James discusses the importance of avoiding jealousy and strife. People should strive for peace and justice instead of concentrating on material pleasures which can tempt people to sin to obtain whatever they desire.

Gospel: Mark 9:30-37

Jesus again attempts to prepare his disciples for his death and resurrection, although they do not yet fully understand. They had been arguing over who was the most important one, but Jesus tells them whoever wants to rank first must be willing to remain a servant to all. He also tells them that anyone who welcomes a child in his name welcomes both him and God

Primera Lectura: Sabiduría 2:12, 17-20

Gente malvada discute su enojo contra el justo, porque no les gusta ser reprochados por sus malos actos. Quieren ver si El es el Hijo de Dios, y deciden torturarlo para ver si Dios vendrá a defenderlo. Deciden condenarlo a una muerte vergonzosa y ver si es verdad que Dios lo cuidará.

Segunda Lectura: Santiago 3:16—4:3

Santiago discute la importancia de evitar celos y disputas. La gente debe tratar de alcanzar paz y justicia en vez de concentrarse en placeres materiales que pueden tentar a la gente a pecar para obtener lo que desean.

Evangelio: San Marcos 9:30-37

Jesús de nuevo intenta preparar a sus discípulos para su muerte y resurrección, a pesar de que no comprenden totalmente. Han estado discutiendo sobre quién era el más importante, pero Jesús les dice que el que desea ser el primero debe ser un sirviente para todos los demás. Les dice también que quien acepta a un niño en su nombre, acepta a ambos: al niño y a Dios.

A Word From the Gospel by Rev. William J. Reilly

“Beloved: Where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there is disorder and every foul practice. But the wisdom from above is first of all pure, then peaceable, gentle, compliant, full of mercy and good fruits, without inconstancy or insincerity. And the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace for those who cultivate peace.”

The teaching of Saint James’ letter provides an excellent format for examining our conscience. Although we usually turn to the ten commandments or the beatitudes to evaluate our Christian lives, consider the virtues or gifts listed above. Think about someone you admire who possesses one or more of this litany of personal gifts. How many are mirrored by me, as I strive to grow in my Christian life?

As the days of political campaigning continue, how distant are we from the ideal presented by St. James? Hate, lies, name calling are the norm, not the needs and remedies we so desperately need.

Pope Francis often refers to cultivation, the process of working or addressing ways to improve. How well do I cultivate peace and avoid jealousy and selfish ambition?

Palabra del Evangelio por Rev. William J. Reilly

“Amados hermanos: donde hay rivalidad y discordia, hay también desorden y toda clase de maldad. En cambio, la sabiduría que viene de lo alto es, ante todo, pura; y además, pacífica, benévola y conciliadora; está llena de misericordia y dispuesta a hacer el bien; es imparcial y sincera. Un fruto de justicia se siembra pacíficamente para los que trabajan por la paz.”

La enseñanza de Santiago provee un formato excelente para examinar nuestra conciencia. A pesar de que generalmente nos enfocamos en los diez mandamientos o bienaventuranzas para evaluar nuestras vidas cristianas, considere la lista de las virtudes o dones mencionadas aquí arriba. Piense en alguien a quien usted admira que posee uno o más de esta litanía de dones personales. ¿Cuántos se reflejan por mí, al intentar crecer en mi vida Cristiana?

Mientras las campañas políticas avanzan, ¿qué tan lejos estamos del ideal presentado por Santiago? Odio, mentiras, insultos son la norma, no las necesidades y remedios que desesperadamente necesitamos.

El Papa Francisco a menudo se refiere al cultivo, como un proceso de trabajo y forma de mejorar. ¿Qué tanto cultivo la paz y evito los celos y la ambición egoísta?
