THIRTY FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

First Reading: Deuteronomy 6:2-6

Moses commands the people to love and fear God, and always keep the commandments that they were given. He tells them to observe all statutes so that they will continue to grow and prosper, and tells them that they must love God with all their soul and strength.

Second Reading: Hebrews 7:23-28

Under the old covenant there were many priests, but Jesus will now remain high priest forever because he will live forever, and always be available to those who want to be saved. He does not need to offer sacrifice every day for the sins of his people, because he offered himself up in payment for their sins.

Gospel: Mark 12:28b-34

One of the scribes asked Jesus which commandment is the first, and he replied that the first is to love and honor the Lord and no one else. Jesus explained that they must love God with all their heart, and love their neighbor. The scribe agreed that loving God completely and loving

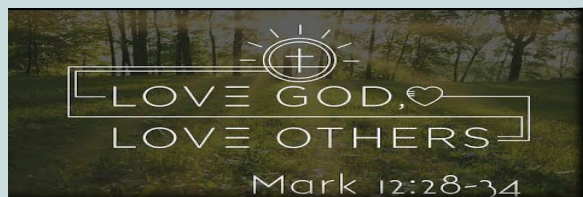

Si el escriba, con su entendimiento, no estaba lejos del reino, me pregunto a mí mismo que tan cerca o lejos estoy yo. ¿En dónde me encuentro, no sólo respondiendo con palabras, sino con acciones? Se dice que la mayor distancia son las dieciocho pulgadas de la cabeza al corazón. Un libro reciente indica que todos damos algo. Jesús lo dió todo.
