

Sixth Sunday of Easter

First Reading: Acts 15:1-2, 22-29

Some men informed the Gentiles that they must be circumcised if they wished to be saved, because of the Old Laws. Disciples then went forth to tell the Gentiles to honor only those rules which were strictly necessary, such as abstaining from eating meat sacrificed to idols and illicit sexual union.

Second Reading: Revelation 21:10-14, 22-23

John depicts Jerusalem coming out of heaven, sparkling with the radiance of precious jewels. Angels were stationed at each of its twelve gates, and each gate bore the name of one tribe of Israel. The city had no temple, because God was its temple. The glory and light of God and the Lamb also replaced their need for the sun.

Gospel: John 14:23-29

Jesus tells his disciples, "Anyone who loves me will be true to my word." For those who do honor his word, both Jesus and God will love them and stay with them always. He also tells them that God will send the Holy Spirit in his place to give them the instructions they will need. Jesus then tells them that peace is his farewell gift to them.

LITURGICAL REMINDER

THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

Then he led them out as far as Bethany, raised his hands, and blessed them. As he blessed them he parted from them and was taken up to heaven.

In the Archdiocese of Newark (and throughout the state of New Jersey), the Ascension of the Lord is observed on the Seventh Sunday of Easter, which occurs on June 1 in 2025. The readings, presidential prayers, and preface are all taken from the Lectionary for Mass and Roman Missal for the Ascension of the Lord.

Please note that on the Sixth Sunday of Easter, "when the Ascension of the Lord is celebrated the following Sunday, the second reading and Gospel from the Seventh Sunday of Easter may be read on the Sixth Sunday of Easter." (Lectionary for Mass)

Thursday, May 29, 2025, is observed everywhere in the Archdiocese as an Easter Weekday [6], Saint Paul VI, Pope (see the Ordo for additional information), and it is not a holy day of obligation.

Anyone from the Archdiocese of Newark who travels to a diocese on May 29, 2025, which observes the Ascension on that day, is not obligated to attend Mass. Anyone from a diocese where the Ascension is observed on Thursday who travels to New Jersey on that day is not obligated to go to Mass that day.




