Third Sunday of Easter

Primera Lectura: Hechos 5:27-32, 40b-41

El gran sacerdote castigó a Pedro y a los otros apóstoles por continuar predicando cuando ya se les había ordenado no hacerlo. Pedro replicó que el prefería obedecer a Dios que a los hombres, considerando que el poder de Dios es mayor que la muerte. Se les advierte que dejen de hablar de Jesús, y luego se les deja libres.

Segunda Lectura: Apocalipsis 5:11-14

Juan tuvo una visión con muchos ángeles y todas las criaturas vivientes del mundo reunidas alrededor de un trono. Los ángeles decían que el Cordero sacrificado era digno de recibir el poder, la gloria y alabanza. Entonces todas las criaturas vivientes de la tierra alababan a Dios y al Cordero, y los ancianos se arrodillaron y adoraron.

Evangelio: San Juan 21:1-19

Jesús se apareció a los discípulos por tercera vez desde su resurrección. Estos pescaban y no habían agarrado nada. Entonces Jesús les aconsejó que tiraran las redes del otro lado del bote. Cuando así lo hicieron, agarraron una gran cantidad de peces. Jesús entonces preguntó a Pedro tres veces "¿Me amas?" Cuando Pedro dijo que sí, Jesús le pidió cuidar y alimentar a sus ovejas.

Palabra del Evangelio por Rev. William J. Reilly

"When they climbed out on shore, they saw a charcoal fire with fish on it and bread, Jesus said to them, 'Bring some of the fish you just caught.' So Simon Peter went over and dragged the net ashore, full of one hundred fifty-three large fish. Even though there were so many, the net was not torn. Jesus said to them: 'Come, have breakfast.' And not one of the disciples dared to ask him, 'who are you', because they realized it was the Lord. Jesus came over and took the bread and gave it to them, and in like manner the fish... This was the third time..." As He fed the multitude, as He invited the disciples today, so we too are invited to the meal He has prepared for us. The descriptive chapter of John's gospel can help us meditate and live the gospel scene. We are at the seashore, perhaps with a gentle breeze and lapping waves. The aroma of frying fish on the barbecue, charcoal fire fills the air. Jesus asks Simon Peter to share some of his catch. Using familiar words, like those at the Eucharist He took the bread and fish, said a blessing and gave it to them. What a breakfast Jesus continues to invite us to His meal, the Eucharist. He knows our hunger and need. He provides what will allow us to grow

in our spiritual lives, yet we unfortunately rush or don't consider


what a great gift and privilege to meet Him, not on the lake shore, but in our parish church. Like the disciples we do not ask

who you are, for we know who both our host and guest is.
