"Hermanos: Lo que yo recibí del Señor, y a mi vez les he transmitido, es lo siguiente: El Señor Jesús, la noche en que fue entregado, tomó el pan, dio gracias, lo partió y dijo: 'Esto es mi Cuerpo, que se entrega por ustedes. Hagan esto en memoria mía'... Y así, siempre que coman este pan y beban esta copa, proclamarán la muerte del Señor hasta que él vuelva." ¿Sabía usted que estas palabras de San Pablo fueron escritas antes que el relato del evangelio de la Última Cena?

Necesito recordar que Jesús me dio este santo sacramento para hacerme santo yo, para sostenerme en mi jornada de fe y permitirme crecer en unión a El. Es la Eucaristía lo que nos hace lo que somos. Pido que este don no sea recibido como de rutina, sino como un nuevo encuentro con mi Salvador, mi momento especial para estar 'uno a uno' con El.

The Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ

First Reading: Genesis 14:18-20

Melchizedek, a priest of God, prayed that Abram would be blessed by God. He also praised God for delivering Abram's foes into his hands.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 11:23-26

Paul describes Jesus' actions during the last supper. Jesus broke bread and said it was his body given for us, asking that we do the same in remembrance of him. He then passed the cup and called it his blood. Jesus then asked us to break bread in this manner to remember his death until he returns.

Gospel: Luke 9:11b-17

Jesus spoke to a large crowd when his disciples asked that he dismiss the people to give them a chance to find food and lodging. Jesus asked the disciples to give the crowd something to eat, but they had only five loaves of bread and two fish. Jesus then blessed and distributed the food, which fed about 5,000 people. Twelve baskets were then collected from what was left over.

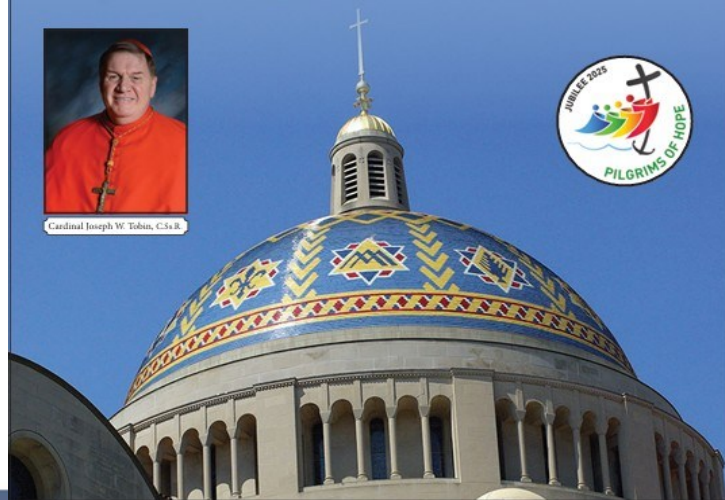
