*A Word From the Gospel*

**“But from the beginning of creation, God made them male and female. For this reason, a man shall leave his father and mother and be joined to his wife, and the two shall become one flesh. So, they are no longer two but one flesh. Therefore, what God has joined together, no human being must separate.”**

The question posed, Mark tells us, was offered to ‘test Jesus.’ He responded clearly and explicitly referring to the Old Testament teaching of Moses. Have we read and reflected? Testing continues today, as we have distanced ourselves from the word of God and His teaching, with legalization of same sex unions, gender transformation. Where are committed Christians who accept such societal change, as all right. We assume we must stop for a red light. We know we are obliged to pay taxes. We should not remain silent when immoral legislation to accommodate the wishes of a particular group are catered to.

What others now call marriage is quite distinct from we who profess our faith in ‘holy matrimony’, a sacred sacrament of the Catholic church, a gift instituted by Jesus Christ. May the word of God today be the nudge to renew our marriage vows and have our marriage blessed in the church. The Lord is waiting for you.

**“Pero desde el principio de la creación, Dios los hizo varón y mujer. Por eso, el hombre dejará a su padre y a su madre, y los dos no serán sino una sola carne. De manera que ya no son dos, sino una sola carne. Que el hombre no separe lo que Dios ha unido.”**

Esa pregunta, nos dice San Marcos, se hizo para ‘poner a Jesús a prueba’. El respondió clara y explícitamente refiriéndose a las enseñanzas de Moisés en el Antiguo Testamento. ¿Hemos leído y reflexionado? La prueba continúa hoy, ya que nos hemos distanciado de la palabra de Dios y Sus enseñanzas, con la legalización de uniones del mismo sexo, transformaciones de género. ¿En dónde están los cristianos comprometidos que aceptan tales cambios sociales como si estuvieran bien? Asumimos que debemos parar cuando hay luz roja. Sabemos que estamos obligados a pagar impuestos. No debemos permanecer callados cuando se pasan leyes inmorales para acomodar los deseos de un grupo en particular.

Lo que otros llaman ahora matrimonio es muy distinto de lo que profesamos en nuestra fe como ‘santo matrimonio’, un sacramento sagrado de la iglesia católica, un don instituido por Jesucristo. Que la palabra de Dios hoy sea la llamada de atención a renovar nuestros votos matrimoniales y a que nuestro matrimonio sea bendecido en la iglesia. El Señor los está esperando.

### **First Reading: Genesis 2:18-24**

God created many different animals in an attempt to make a suitable partner for the first man. Then he took a rib from the man as he slept and built it up into a woman. At last God had created someone who equaled the man, as she was “bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh” and they proved to be suitable partners for each other.

### **Second Reading: Hebrews 2:9-11**

This passage describes how Jesus will become perfect through his suffering. It also reminds us that Jesus’ Father is our Father as well, making him unashamed to call us his brothers and sisters.

### **Gospel: Mark 10:2-16**

The people began to ask Jesus if it was acceptable for a man to divorce his wife. Jesus tells them that two people who have been joined together by God should not be separated. People began bringing their children to Jesus, but the disciples tried to send them away. Jesus grew angry and told his disciples to allow the children to come to him.

### **Primera Lectura: Génesis 2:18-24**

### **Segunda Lectura: Hebreos 2:9-11**

Este pasaje describe cómo Jesús se volverá perfecto a través de su sufrimiento. Nos recuerda que el Padre de Jesús es nuestro Padre también, haciendo que Jesús nos llame hermanos y hermanas sin avergonzarse.

### **Evangelio: San Marcos 10:2-16**

La gente empezó a preguntar a Jesús si era aceptable que un hombre se divorciara de su esposa. Jesús les dice que dos personas que han sido unidas por Dios no pueden separarse. La gente empezó a traer los niños a Jesús, pero los discípulos trataron de alejarlos. Jesús se enojó y le dijo a sus discípulos que permitieran que los niños vinieran a Él.
