3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time

First Reading: Nehemiah 8:2-4a, 5-6, 8-10

Ezra gathered the people and read to them from the book of the Law of God. He interpreted the law clearly, so that everyone understood what he had read. He then told them to go and rejoice in the Lord.

Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 12:12-30

Paul explains that a body is composed of many different parts, and that each part has its own purpose and is important. He compares this to the Church, describing how we are one body composed of many members. All members should show concern for each other and understand that we are all vital to the body as a whole.

Gospel: Luke 1:1-4, 4:14-21

Luke discusses his decision to write about the events he and the other disciples had witnessed. He begins by telling of Jesus reading a passage from the book of Isaiah, where the anointed one is portrayed. Jesus finished by telling the people that they had seen that passage fulfilled in their hearing.

Palabra del Evangelio por

"Jesús fue a Nazaret, donde se había criado; el sábado entró como de costumbre en la sinagoga y se levantó para hacer la lectura. Le presentaron el libro del profeta Isaías y, abriéndolo, encontró el pasaje donde estaba escrito: 'El Espíritu del Señor está sobre mí, porque me ha consagrado por la unción. El me envió a llevar la Buena Noticia a los pobres, a anunciar la liberación a los cautivos y la vista a los ciegos, a dar la libertad a los oprimidos y proclamar un año de gracia del Señor.'"

Encontramos a San Lucas describiendo las buenas nuevas del evangelio, trazando la vida de Jesús desde el comienzo de Su ministerio. El regreso de Jesús a su terruño, su regreso, lo encuentra usando a Isaías para revelar Su ministerio y misión. Busque las palabras clave: ungido, enviado a proclamar libertad, abrir los ojos, y asegurar la libertad a aquellos injustamente secuestrados, o que han caído en adicciones que los controlan. Las necesidades de Su tiempo son quizá mayores hoy.

Estamos celebrando el año de jubileo, un año de esperanza en un mundo en pena. Ojalá veamos la misión de Jesús como nuestra, la misión de la Iglesia en este 2025.

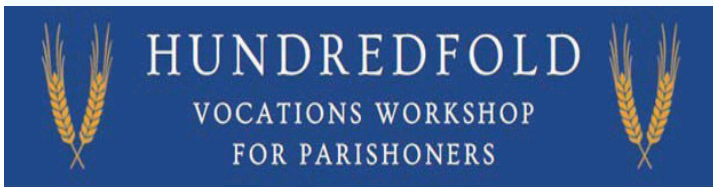

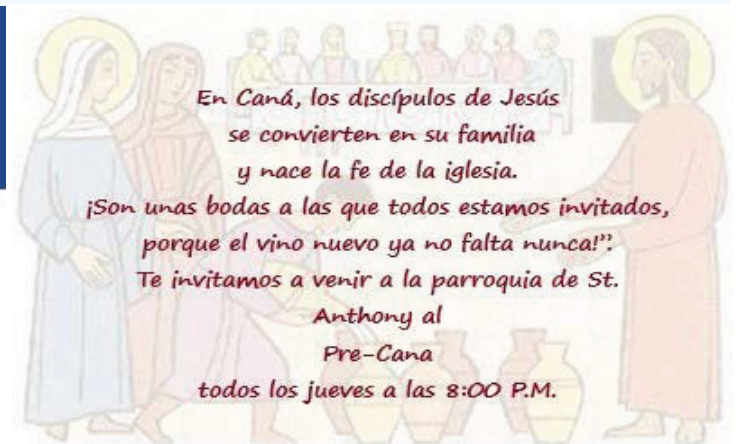
