Primera Lectura: Isaías 50:4-7

Segunda Lectura: Filipenses 2:6-11

Pablo discute cómo Jesús no exigió semejanza con Dios, sino que tomó forma humana. Se humilió suficientemente como para aceptar morir en la aruz. Dios lo exattó y quiere que nosotros respetemos el nombre de Jesús y lo adoremos.

Evangelio: San Lucas 22:14-23:56

Lucas cuenta detalladamente sobre la última cena de Jesús con los apóstoles, en donde Jesús les dice que pronto sufiriá para cumplir la voluntad de Dios. Luego Jesús aró para que Dios lo librara si lo deseaba. Después de que Judas lo traicionó, fué arrestado. A pesar de que Platos no areyó que Jesús fuera culpable de ningún atimen, se lo entregó al pueblo, y sentenció a Jesús a moir en la aruz. Luego de que Jesús fué arucificado, pusieron su cuerpo en un sepularo nuevo.

Palabra del Evangelio por Rev. William J. Reilly

"Christ Jesus, though he was in true form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness, and found human in appearance, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross."

Scholars tell us that this prayer of Saint Paul was probably a hymn, detailing the unlimited love of God for us. He became one of us, to identify with us in our need, but not abandoning His Godhead. He emptied Himself, gave everything of Himself in His death, with only one thing in mind, that we might have a new life.

We were in a desperate situation. Unfortunately, we take the facts for granted. You can decide to make this a truly holy week by becoming more aware of not just the what of our need, but the why He came to save us.

2025 LENTEN REGULATIONS

1) The days of both Fast and Abstinence during Lent are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. If possible, the fast on Good Friday is continued until the Easter Vigil (on Holy Saturday niaht) as the "paschal fast" to honor suffering and death of the Lord Jesus, and to prepare ourselves to share more fully and to celebrate more readily His Resurrection. The other Fridays of Lent are days of Abstinence.

*On a day of Fast, only one (1) full meal is permitted, and two (2) smaller meals, which, if added together, would not exceed the main meal in quantity. Those between the ages of 18 and 59 are obliged to fast. *On a day of Abstinence, no meat may be eaten. Those who have reached the age of 14 are obliged by the law of abstinence.

- 2) The obligation to observe the laws of Fast and Abstinence "substantially", or as a whole, is a serious obligation.
- 3) The Fridays of the year, outside of Lent, are designated as days of penance, but each individual may substitute for the traditional abstinence from meat some other practice of voluntary self-denial as penance.
- 4) The time for fulfilling the Paschal Precept (Easter Duty*) extends from the First Sunday of Lent, March 9, 2025 to the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity, May 15, 2025. **Canon 920, §1.

All the faithful, after they have been initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, are bound by the obligation of receiving Communion at least once a year.


