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COMMISSIONERS MEETING

August 13, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm. Commissioners Tim Young, Bob Rohrick were present as well as Chief Fuller and Asst. Chief Foxworthy. Commissioner Victorino was out on a fire call. The meeting was also available virtually or via phone call for any member of the public who would like to attend. The agenda was approved. The minutes from the last meeting were amended and approved. The treasurer and BARs percentage reports were reviewed. The checking and payroll bank accounts were reviewed.

Respiratory illness update:

- RSV, acute respiratory illness, COVID-19 and the flu were all about the same as last month.

Energy report including usage at Station 2:

- The usage was consistent at both stations.

Western Skamania County Public Service Complex (WSCPSC):

- Certificate of occupancy has been issued by the county for the new living quarters.

WA State Ratings Bureau (WSRB):

- Chief Fuller will post the new protection class (that will affect home insurance for those living within 5 miles of the station) on our web site when he receives the final, official letter.

Storedahl & Sons Quarry:

- A member of the community (Keith Brown) informed the Commissioners that there have been around 160 letters to the county (including 2 lawyers) opposing the quarry.
- Keith Brown read aloud a heart-felt letter from the community opposing the conditional use permit (CUP) for the quarry.
- He also read a letter penned by the lawyer from 500 Trucks.
- They all discussed the environmental impact it would have on our community.
- Washougal City Council, the Port of Camas/Washougal and many other entities oppose the CUP.

America's Phone Guys proposal:

- Chief Fuller distributed a proposal from The Phone Guys that would replace our old phone system with a much improved one.
- Commissioner Young made a motion to approve the \$1821.75 proposal by America's Phone Guys; it was seconded by Commissioner Rohrick and the motion passed. Commissioner Young made a motion to approve the \$372.29 to add the phone system in the new living quarters; it was seconded by Commissioner Rohrick and the motion passed.

Unclaimed warrants:

- Resolution 2026-02 was signed to void a check we sent in April of 2024 for \$130.73.

Vouchers totaling: \$298,989.63 were approved and signed by the Commission.

Payroll totaling \$4,483.91 approved and signed by the Commission.

Meeting adjourned at 6:52pm by Commissioner Young.
