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COMMISSIONERS MEETING

July 9, 2026

The meeting was called to order at 6:00pm. Commissioners Tim Young, Bob Rohrick and Robert Victorino were present as well as Chief Fuller and Asst. Chief Foxworthy. The meeting was also available virtually or via phone call for any member of the public who would like to attend. The agenda was amended and approved. The minutes from the last meeting were approved. The treasurer and auditor reports were reviewed. The county changed accounting programs and may not have auditor reports for the next month. Secretary Cartan will produce a spread sheet to show our expenditures. The checking and payroll bank accounts were reviewed.

Respiratory illness update:

- RSV, acute respiratory illness and the flu were all down a bit from last month.
- COVID-19 was up a bit.

Energy report including usage at Station 2:

- The usage was consistent at both stations.

Western Skamania County Public Service Complex (WSCPSC):

- We have received our first reimbursement from the State Grant and Chief Fuller will submit the next one (\$249,101.42) for repayment.
- Our cash-on-hand is below our projected amount, but the next reimbursement will be deposited within the week to bring that figure back up.

WA State Ratings Bureau (WSRB):

- Chief Fuller will post the new protection class (that will affect home insurance for those living within 5 miles of the station) on our web site when he receives the final, official letter.

Storedahl & Sons Quarry:

- Commission Chair Young allowed public comment on this subject.
- Keith Brown and Teresa Robbins are submitting a 9-page letter (in regards to their safety concerns) to the County Commission in addition to the letter we sent written by Commissioner Victorino.
- The County has hired a lawyer, a statistical engineer and a traffic engineer to investigate the conditional use permit for the quarry.

Training Grounds Containers:

- Assistant Chief Foxworthy distributed a quote from DryBox for the 2 training grounds containers.
- Commissioner Young made a motion to accept the quote for the purchase of 2 containers; Commissioner Victorino seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Soha sign quote:

- Chief Fuller handed out 4 examples of a reader-board to replace the existing one that will include logos for the Sheriff's Dept. and SCEMs.
- The Commission chose example D as did the department Officers.
- Commissioner Young made a motion to accept quote and example D; Commissioner Rohrick seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Vouchers totaling: \$268,537.21 were approved and signed by the Commission.

Payroll totaling \$4,298.73 approved and signed by the Commission.

Meeting adjourned at 6:47pm by Commissioner Young.
