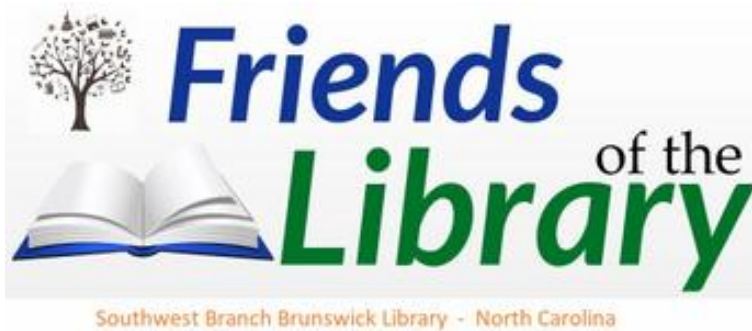

It is time to renew your membership in the Friends of the Library, those membership fees are used to purchase our movies, current new book releases and patron requests.

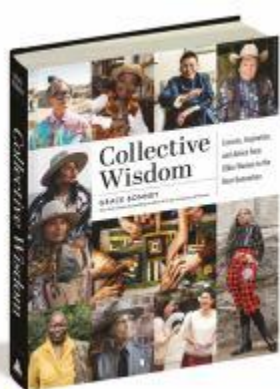
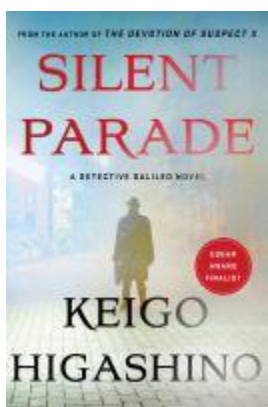
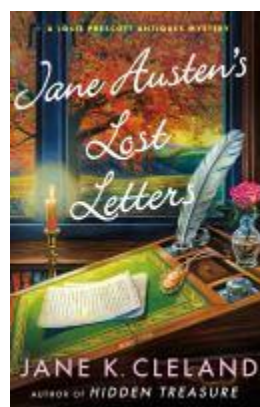
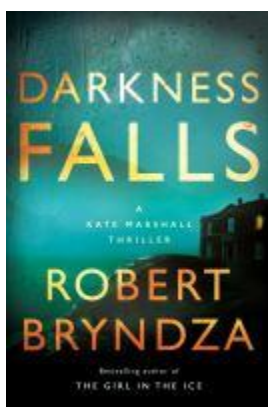
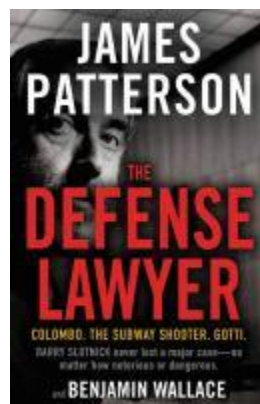
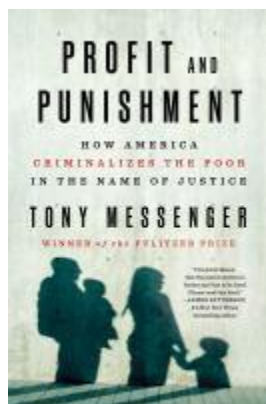
