## **DEVON GARDNER Appointed Senior Partner of The Institute for Innovation and Growth (IIG)**

GROS ISLET, SAINT LUCIA, 11 NOVEMBER 2024: The Institute for Innovation and Growth Inc., a Regional Think Tank for Science, Technology, Economics, and Sustainable Development, is pleased to announce the appointment of Dr. Devon Gardner as Senior Partner, effective 1<sup>st</sup> November 2024.

Dr. Gardner is an established thought-leader in the field of science and technology, with specialization in the areas of climate and energy. He joins the Institute after three years as the Head of Technical Programmes at the Centre for Renewable Energy and Energy Efficiency (CCREEE), the energy-specialized agency for the Caribbean Community (CARICOM), where he led a multidisciplinary technical team that implemented innovative and country-appropriate initiatives and projects, and provided science-driven decision-support on complex issues, that contributed to accelerating the just energy transition in Member States.

Prior to his tenure at the CCREEE, Dr. Gardner served as Head of the Energy Unit at the CARICOM Secretariat for over seven years. Dr. Gardner also served as a Sustainable Energy Advisor within the Caribbean Community Climate Change Centre (5Cs) between 2010 and 2014, and has held multiple appointments in academia, ranging from *Senior Research Fellow* to *Professor* in universities within the Caribbean and Europe.

Dr. Gardner holds a Ph.D. in Chemical Physics (2001) with specialization in numerical analysis and modelling from the University of the West Indies (Mona Campus) in Jamaica. He has over two decades of dedicated and reliable experience and expertise within the energy sector, spanning a deep understanding of *molecular-level behaviour* in such areas as hydrogen storage and fuel cells, to *macro-level* areas such as energy diplomacy, energy policy and regulations, energy planning, multi-criteria decision analysis. He is responsible for the design and implementation of several low-carbon strategies and projects on energy within the Caribbean.
