- Are interested in a career in law enforcement.
- Are a Canadian citizen or permanent resident.

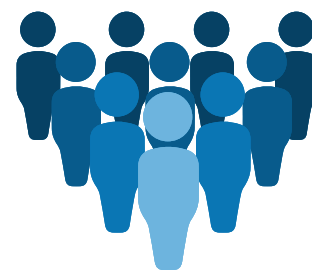
Application Porcess
