An incorporated non-profit peer support organization for 2SLGBTQ+ members of law enforcement.



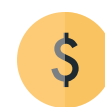
## Focus

- Are currently enrolled or accepted into a full time academic post secondary program.
- Are interested in a career in law enforcement.
- Are a Canadian citizen or permanent resident.

## Application Process

The application consists of short answer questions, an essay, and resume evaluation. The Out On Patrol board of directors will form the selection committee.
