- Any Equine or rider deemed out of control will be excused.

- Boots, Long Sleeves & Long Pants Required
- No Schooling Aids Allowed
- Please leave your dogs at home.
- **NO SMOKING ON THE GROUNDS**
- Helmets suggested & welcome for all riders.
- Youths entered in 10 & Under & Leadline classes Must wear ASTM/SEI approved Helmets except in Halter and Showmanship Classes
- No Cross Entry Between Leadline & other divisions
- No Cross Entry Between 10 & Under and any canter classes.
- Youths entering 13 & under classes cannot also enter 10 & under classes regardless of their age

Academy Class: This class is designed for people with very little to no show experience.

Novice Equine: Not to have been shown under saddle prior to June 1, 2015. Not to have been under saddle for more than one year prior to that date. A horse 6 & older must be shown in an appropriate bit for their age.

Junior Equine: 5 years and younger

Senior Equine: 6 Years and Older

Colored Equine: Must show visible color

Jackpot: Class winner to take home ½ of the class entry fees.

IF THERE ARE ENOUGH 18 & OVER RIDERS TO SPLIT THIS DIVISION INTO 18-38 and 39 & OVER WE WILL. *Decision will be based on this: If we have at least 3 competitors in one division (either 18-38 or 39 & Over, then at least 3 in the other -- and those numbers are consistent at all 4 shows -- Those classes will be separated at each show and then award 2 High Point Buckles)*

Points to accumulate at all 3 shows for Overall High Point. Riders must show in at least 2 of the 3 shows to be eligible for the Overall High Point awards. High points must be **one Equine/Rider combination— however, Leadline points will accumulate on rider only.**

Series Buckles for: Leadline, Novice Equine, Academy Class. If there is enough attendance for these classes, buckles will be awarded. If fewer than 3 attendants in each of these divisions at each show another suitable award will be given.

Points tabulated as follows:

1st: 10, 2nd: 8, 3rd: 6, 4th: 4, 5th: 2, 6th: 1

- Bonus points will be given to Champion and Reserve winners of the "Championship" classes. 2 points to the Champion and 1 to the Reserve Champion

Series Awards: Will be presented at the end of the Last show in the series unless specific sizes need ordering or custom embroidery. You will then be asked to fill out forms with Blanket or Jacket sizes.

Overall High Point Awards: All classes possible excluding Novice Horse and Academy Class count for the Overall High Point Awards for the series.

Division Awards:

Halter, Leadline, Academy Rider, 10 & Under, 13 & Under, 14-17 and 18 & Over. Overall English, Overall Western
