Yalkut Mordechai: Notes from Rabbi Gross

When Winter Isn't, We Still Are

As I write this, midweek in mid-January, the pre-dawn temperature had dropped way down into the low 50s, which found me "layering" like the Clicquot Club eskimo to head out... into a day that ended up being shirt-sleeve weather in the low 70s. It is hard for us, here in our semi-tropical paradise, to relate to the harshness of Winter; after all, the only snow we know around here is the snow-white sand on the beaches by the always-balmy Gulf of Mexico.

Herschel of Ostrepol, the famous Hasidic jester, was notoriously underpaid. When he hinted that he needed a little more money to meet his family's needs in Winter, the rebbe grumbled: "Let me know what you need, in a sufficiently entertaining roundabout way, and maybe I can throw a few more thalers your way." Frowning thoughtfully, Herschel observed: "You know, rabbi, Jack Frost is a notorious skirt-chaser!" Surprised, the rabbi demanded, "How's



that?" "Well, Herschel shrugged, "just this morning he put the moves on my wife, and I couldn't even find a stick of stove wood to drive him off!"

Yet barely a century ago most of our families lived in northern Europe or European Russia, at latitudes so high that snow and ice, and the discomfort and even perils of coping with them, were an everyday reality and a challenge indeed.

A rabbi soliciting alms to help underwrite the needs of the suffering poor challenged to find work during the Winter months, came to the mansion of the wealthiest member of his congregation. Ignoring the invitation to come in, he chatted for a while about local affairs while the householder stood shivering at the open door. When the rabbi finally got around to the business at hand, the host willingly agreed—but, as he handed over the very generous gift of a fifty-ruble note, he asked the rabbi: "Why didn't you come join me inside, and discuss the needs of the poor over a glass of tea by the fire?" To which the rabbi, smiling shyly, answered: "I wanted to make sure that you had an opportunity to feel 'the needs of the poor' for yourself."

So while the traumas of Winter are very much a part of our landscape, we also have rich folkloric traditions preserving the ways that we, as a true community worthy of the name, have always helped and supported each other—whatever the weather or season.

In the Old Country, where "at three I started Hebrew School," it was the practice for the older children to leave for cheder in the morning earlier than the youngsters. In part that is because the pre- and early-teens counted in the minyan, and were required to attend daily worship— but it was also so that, in the Winter season, the older and bigger boys, going to the academy first, could tramp down the snow and make a path so it would be easier for the little children to follow in turn.

As we continue to confront a Winter of the spirit, compelled by circumstances to interact only from a distance, may the fact that we are still Us—the JCMI Family—offer each of us the reassurance that we are more than virtually walking the same path to make it easier for everyone else to follow along... and meet up back at our Temple home as soon as we properly can.

Our policy at JCMI is to offer members the choice of recording Yahrtseit dates in accordance with the English or Hebrew calendars.

If members choose to remember loved ones on their Yahrtseit using the English date of death, the Yahrtseit will be observed each year on the Friday Evening of the week in which that English date occurs.

If the Hebrew date is chosen, the Hebrew date falls on a different English date each year. The Yahrtseit will be observed each year on the Friday evening of the week when that Hebrew date occurs.

Please inform the office as to which date you observe the Yahrtseit of your loved one so that it can be properly recorded in our records. I hope this clarified and eliminates confusion about our policy.


