Yalkut Mordechai: Notes from Rabbi Gross

A Promise Fulfilled... in Time

"Then the prophecies of the old songs have turned out to be true, after a fashion!" said Bilbo. "Of course!" said Gandalf. "And why should not they prove true? Surely you don't disbelieve the prophecies, because you had a hand in bringing them about yourself?"

- John R. R. Tolkein, The Hobbit

I have always been taken by that quote from Prof. Tolkein's famous fantasy novel. It speaks mightily to our assumptions that our heritage is mere folklore; that our corporate convictions are only poetry; and that any event we experience, merely because of its immediacy, must be mundane and devoid of any inner meaning.

I am particularly mindful of that at this time of year, when Passover rolls around. After all, this once-a-year Spring holiday, which is such a powerful framework for our religious and cultural identity as Jews, commemorates the long-ago moment when The Holy And Blessed One pierced the veil of mystery and intervened in human history to birth the Jewish People.

I wonder how our forebears at the time responded to that experience. We are told in chapter 4 of the Biblical book of Exodus that, upon Moses's first arrival in Egypt to confront Pharaoh on their behalf.

they heard that The Eternal One had taken note of the Israelites and had seen their plight, they bowed low in homage.

But their initial hope turns to disillusionment and despair. Pharaoh responds to Moses's agitation on their behalf by making their labor harder. And one plague after another, striking at the Egyptian people, serves only to harden Pharaoh's resolve to maintain power over them.

So they must have been truly stunned when, at last, in the wee hours of the morning with the full moon's light overhead they are summarily thrust out of Egypt in haste and released to freedom.

That event had been foretold long ago. Centuries earlier, 'way back in Genesis 15, God had informed Abraham not only that he would personally would never have title to the Promised Land, but that it would not even become the legacy of his future descendants until they had endured four generations of servitude in a foreign land.

But I will execute judgment on the nation that had enslaved them, and in the end they shall go free with great wealth.

Our long-ago forebears knew of that tradition. They knew their descent from Abraham, and the Covenant faith that he had passed down through his heirs: after all, God's credentials to Moses in Exodus 3, and to the Israelite tribal leaders in Exodus 4 was framed as

the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob.

But I have to wonder if they extrapolated from that lineage the promise that had been made to their ancestors regarding themselves.

As I point out every year, the Passover *seider* commemorates not our liberation, but rather our last night as slaves. May we not be slaves of uncertainty and doubt, but rather servants of The Most High... Who summons us to hope and faith and aspiration and glorious fulfillment.


Summer Worship Leaders Sought
