Yalkut Mordechai: Notes from Rabbi Gross

A Vortel Out-of-Season

I am away from the JCMI community during the Summer months, and will return to the pulpit in September. I earnestly hope the members of Temple family—not to mention, your own family and friends—are well and safe, and that everyone will be back together at the Synagogue long before our new program and activity year at Summer's end.

In the interim, I offer a schtikeleh Toyre ("a little slice of Torah") to see the Congregational family through my hiatus months.

One of the most interesting Torah narratives coming up this Summer (which we will explore in next year's LifeLong Learning session, "Torah Out of Season") is the episode of Bil'am, the Mesopotamian prophet who

came halfway across the world to "read God into the record" for the nations neighboring Israel. The best-known aspect of the story is Bil'am's talking donkey: she was astute enough to bow before the angel of wrath blocking the road, whom the great prophet didn't even discern as being there. However, that humorous detail is completely incidental to Bil'am's ensuing poetic pronouncements, which are an enduring source of spiritual meaning.





Numbers 23:9 -

וּבַגוֹיִם לֹא יִתְחַשֵּׁב

הֶן-עָם לְבַדַר יִשְׁכֹּן

Behold, this is a people dwelling apart,

not reckoned among the other nations.

Mosheh Chayim Epstein of Sudilkov (1725?-1800) taught: "I paraphrase this verse as 'he shall reckon with the other nations.' The secret of the survival of our People of Israel, while scattered among the other nations, lies in the fact that we have always gone our own way, and lived our own lives, regardless of what other nations have to say about us—whether in praise or scorn."

Numbers 23:10 -

ּ הָּהִי אַחֲרִיתִי כָּמֹהוּ May my soul die the death of the upright; may my end be like that of Israel!

One of the Hasidim of Shalom Rogei'ach of Belz (1820?-1894) expressed his fervent desire to die as a good Jew. To his surprise, the Rabbi said: "Pardon me, my friend, but that is as unworthy as the aspiration of the wicked prophet Bil'am to 'die the death of the upright.' Better that you should desire to live your life as a good Jew—in which case your eventually dying as a good Jew will take care of itself."

NOTES FROM OUR CANTORIAL SOLOIST

Who would've thunk things would be as they are today? Of all things to share with the entire world? A pandemic! While humbling, it's an extraordinary opportunity to practice (or, if necessary, to establish and practice) positive thinking. And it truly is a choice. Granted, for some of us, positive thinking comes more readily than to others. But, regardless, all too often it does not come on its own.



Twice this summer we will read in the book of Deuteronomy of God's extraordinary gift to us; choice. In fact, it spells out that God has set before us a blessing and a curse; to choose life (the blessing) that we and our children may live. While, clearly, we do not always have that particular choice, we do have many choices and they come chronically.

Thank you, God, for the gift of choice.

Right now, however, many of our choices are very mundane. How long do we need to keep large social distances? How long do we keep so many businesses closed? What does it take to be safe? For our family and friends to be safe? For everyone to be safe?

But, just as described in the Torah, those choices will, in turn, both affect us and our children (our children's children, our children's children's children ...) — and even whether we and they will live. It couldn't be more relevant if it had to be. Dang! Sometimes the timeliness of the Torah is a real bummer?

But, also as in the Torah, there are many instances where individuals are saved.

Of course, there's Noah from the flood; Moses in the bulrushes; Isaac on Mount Moriah; Joseph from his brothers.... The list is almost endless. There are far more blessings than curses; some given to us directly, and some as the result of the gift of choice.

May we work hard and take advantage of God's precious gift of "choice", and may we recognize and appreciate the saving moments we encounter not only in the Torah, but that we encounter every day.

And may we each stay safe.



If the Hebrew date is chosen, the Hebrew date falls on a <u>different English date each year</u>. The Yahrtseit will be observed each year on the Friday evening of the week when that Hebrew date occurs.

Please inform the office as to which date you observe the Yahrtseit of your loved one so that it can be properly recorded in our records. I hope this clarified and eliminates confusion about our policy.


