A Vortel Out-of-Season

I am away from the JCMI community during the Summer months, and will return to the pulpit in September.

In the interim, I offer a schtikeleh Toyre (“a little slice of Torah”) to see the Congregational family through my hiatus months.



One of the literary masterworks of the Jewish people is “The Testaments of the Twelve Patriarchs.” This treatise from 2200 years ago is couched as an ethical will from Jacob’s sons, founders of the Tribes of Israel, each of whom in turn offers the distilled wisdom of a lifetime as guidance for us who are their descendants.

In view of our Congregants being Islanders (and many of them boaters), I



thought it might be nice to share from “The Testament of the Twelve Patriarchs” the ethical legacy of Jacob’s tenth-born son זְבוּלוֹן Z’vulun/Zebulun, a maritime man whose father blessed him to “dwell by the seashore as a haven for ships.”

My children, I entreat you to keep the commandments of The Eternal One by showing mercy to your neighbors, and demonstrating compassion towards all— not just other people, but to beasts and animals as well. Have compassion in your hearts; for just as we do to others, even so will The Eternal One do for us.

I was the first to make a sailing ship for the sea, and have coasted along— catching fish for my father’s household— all the way to Egypt. Through my endeavors to be compassionate, I shared freely of my catch with anyone in need; and, if they were aged or infirm, I filleted the fish and cooked them in accord their particular need, grieving with them and sharing comfort at their condition. Whereupon The Eternal One met my needs with an abundance of fish: for who shares with his neighbors, receives manifold blessings from God.

Seeing a person in distress through his exposure in the Winter, I took compassion upon him and secured a garment from my father’s house to give to the one in distress. You do the same, my children, from that with which God has bestowed upon you, showing compassion and mercy without reservation to all in need, giving with an open hand and a good heart. And even if you cannot meet his need, demonstrate your compassion from the depths of your being.

See the ocean’s waters, how they flow along together in a single current among the shore boulders and coastal trees and promontories of the earth. But if they are divided into numerous streams, then the earth swallows them up and they are gone from sight; the same can befall you, my children, if you be divided. Note instead how The Eternal One has made one head; one shoulder, to unite the two arms; and one hip, to unite the two legs: the whole of it is one abiding organic unity, blessed with its one-ness by the One Who made it all!

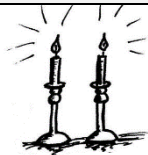
and to download a copy of our “Readers Digest Siddur for Distance-Davvening.”

God will be telling us that making a choice is not only a matter of life and death for us, but even more profoundly, that these choices will affect our children, our children's children,

So, let's take our non-life-threatening challenges of these very difficult times as golden opportunities to rein in all our choice possibilities and to take them – one by one - seriously and to heart.

Remember: Repeatedly in the Torah, it specifies that this IS God's will.

Our policy at JCMI is to offer members the choice of recording Yahrtseit dates in accordance with the English or Hebrew calendars.

If members choose to remember loved ones on their Yahrtseit using the English date of death, the Yahrtseit will be observed each year on the Friday Evening of the week in which that English date occurs.

If the Hebrew date is chosen, the Hebrew date falls on a different English date each year. The Yahrtseit will be observed each year on the Friday evening of the week when that Hebrew date occurs.

Please inform the office as to which date you observe the Yahrtseit of your loved one so that it can be properly recorded in our records. I hope this clarified and eliminates confusion about our policy.
