Gene Autry Judaism

The pandemic continues, a year later, and even with more Americans vaccinated daily every responsible person is still taking sensible steps to stay safe and be a good neighbor. Yet we find ourselves cautiously emerging from our sheltering places and beginning to resume something resembling a normal life once more.

That includes the resumption of live worship at JCMI. We are now convening for Friday night services, as of last May. Access and participation continue to be subject to reasonable safety steps, that are constantly evaluated and refined by our Congregational leadership— but nonetheless the doors are



open again, and we can enjoy the pleasure of real-time engagement with each other in our beautiful Temple home rather than on-screen Bette Midler-style, "from a distance"

I, myself, for the time being continue to be distant a little longer. Even though JCMI is a full-time Congregation, from the rabbinic end it is only a part-time pulpit, and as such it will be several more weeks before I return to join Cantor Jacobsen in sharing Shabbat with our Temple family.

However, my seasonal return will be a little earlier than usual this time around, since the vagaries of the Jewish calendar are such that this year Rosh haShanah begins on Labor Day. Inasmuch my responsibilities to the Congregation begin with conduct of Shabbat worship and Torah-study on the



weekend of *S'lichot*, that means that this year instead of singing "See You in September," I will be, like Gene Autry, "Back In The Saddle Again" as of the tail end of August. Aptly enough, the weekly Torah *parashah* on August 28 is *Ki Tavo*, the very name of which signifies "once you have come in...."

I invite you to join me in celebrating that Shabbat together, as well as doing the evocative soul-work in preparation for the coming New Year season at our

S'lichot service at 8:30 on the evening of August 28.

And let this message serve as a reminder that, with the New Year coming up so very soon, it's time to submit your names for our Yom Kippur Book of Memory, and to renew your JCMI membership— not just to be eligible to attend our worship services welcoming 5782, but to demonstrate your pride in and joyous commitment to the synagogue home to which all of us are returning in joy, "Back In The Saddle Again."

<u>Friday, August 13</u> [candles 7:46] — *Qabbalat Shabbat* worship.



PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

THE NEW FISCAL YEAR 2021 BEGINS

Last March 2020 began a worrisome period for your President. It is my judgment that one of the President's chief roles is to make certain there are sufficient funds to operate the Synagogue. When the Board of Directors suspended activities due to covid, both inside the Synagogue and out, I wondered how we would meet the budget for our upcoming 2020-2021 season.



We closed out our 2019 fiscal year with a whimper. We shut down Bingo, the third event of the Concert Series was canceled, the final movie of the Jewish Film Festival was also canceled, and our famous Duplicate Bridge, along with Social Bridge, could no longer meet. All these important sources of funding for the Synagogue, not only canceled but many funds had to be returned.

Our 2020 fiscal year began quietly. Though most of our members returned, paying their dues in good faith to keep us up and running, we lost many long-time members. We were fortunate to secure a forgivable loan, and generous bequests from the Miller and Margolis estates. We rallied and were able to offer long-distance High Holy Day services, several movies from our Jewish Film Festival and the Cultural Series returned with three events. Though attendance was not record-breaking, we were blessed to be able to stay connected to our membership and community.

It is with pride that I announce that we finished the 2020 fiscal year in the black.

Now, a new fiscal year for the Synagogue begins July 1st, 2021, and will end June 30th 2022. We are excited to be open once again and are optimistic that we can have a successful season with concerts, movies and presenters. I encourage your prompt attention to our annual dues to help us get started with the new season ahead and achievement of financial soundness – maintaining our Jewish presence on Marco Island.


