Yalkut Mordechai: Notes from Rabbi Gross

A Vortel Out-of-Season

I am away from the JCMI community during the Summer months, and will return to the pulpit in September. In the interim, I offer a seasonal thought as a schtikeleh Toyre ("a little slice of Torah") to see the Congregational family through my hiatus months.

This Summer season includes the long-ago destruction of Jerusalem by the armies of the Babylonian Empire. They broke through the walls of the city on the 17th of Tammuz (still observed as a partial fast-day), and three weeks later began the dismantling of the Temple on the 9th of Av (which is still observed as a full day of fasting and lamenting). Indeed, Tish'ah b'Av marks a remembrance of every disaster that has ever befallen our people: not just the Babylonian destruction, but the Roman sack of the Second Temple in the first century, and the expulsion of the Jews of Spain in the 15th.

An awareness about, and memory of, past tragedies is important for us— not just in general, but as a frame of reference in our own divisive and mean-spirited era when anti-Semitic words and actions have so dramatically proliferated in recent years.

The Talmud tells of a merchant who, in the course of his travels, encountered a wolf on the road. For a long time thereafter, he constantly told people about having survived a run-in with a wolf.

Then he had occasion to meet up with a lion, and managed somehow to escape death at <u>its</u> ravening jaws—subsequent to which, he recounted <u>that</u> adventure, to the exclusion of the other prior encounter.

Still later on, he crossed paths with a venomous serpent. Having eluded a painful death from its poisonous fangs, he told only about his escape from the snake.

Which anecdote the Talmudic sages conclude by pointing out that it is just like that with the People of Israel: every new danger that we encounter, makes us forget the former ones.

Let's count our blessings, and remember the vast scope of our experience—the triumphs, as well as the tragedies—while on the one hand giving thanks for our salvation, and on the other hand closing ranks and reinforcing the bonds that give us the strength to face new challenges together.


A Yankee Doodle Shabbat

In honor of the Independence Day celebration earlier that week, patriotic melodies and themes will be featured in our Shabbat worship service on Friday night, July 05.



Virtually every reading in our Shabbat liturgy (Shabbat service texts) has many musical settings. Some we "like" mostly because we're used to hearing them that way. Some we "like" because, in fact, they have such beautiful melodies. Others we don't care for much - for similarly opposite reasons as those for liking them. Clearly, though, whether or not we've personally heard



many different ones, there are very many settings from which a cantor, soloist, song leader, and/or rabbi can choose - or any of us, for that matter.

And that brings us to one specific text, Am Yisra'eil Chai (The People of Israel Lives). Very interestingly, quite recently there have been many new musical versions of Am Yisra'eil Chai. I have little doubt that mostly there is but one reason for the inspiration of new compositions with this title; a rise in antisemitism. Not only have new melodies been written, but lyrics have been added, as well; lyrics in various languages, I should add. Regardless of the variances, the theme is very constant and very meaningful - certainly to the composers and performers.

With or without the Hamas attack on Israel on October 7, 2023, antisemitism has radically increased in recent times. The Hamas attack and the subsequent fighting have simply intensified the problem.

Deep feelings have always inspired art forms - whether musical, graphic, choreographed, theatrical - whatever type of medium - and whether intense love, intense hatred, intense jealousy - whatever emotion.

May the next wave of creativity be inspired by great joy - and in the very near future.


