## **Easing Out the Clutch**

A parable: the sidesaddle was invented because it was regarded as un-seemly, and medically hazardous, for women to ride astride a horse (not to mention impractical, while wearing long dresses!). The sidesaddle let women get out and take the air, or undertake journeys overland; but it also made for a frankly passive experience. Until the High Middle Ages, women's horses were led on a halter by another rider, while the lady in the sidesaddle literally just sat there and went along for the ride.

The parallel: when the global pandemic made it necessary earlier this year to close our synagogue for Shabbat worship and other public gatherings, we invoked both creative energy and modern technology to keep up the momentum of Congregational life. Our pulpit staff mobilized the means to conduct Friday night services live on-line by Zoom; our Board provided the means to bring High Holy Days worship into your home live from our beautiful synagogue; and we furnished our members with a “Satellite *Siddur*” to “keep you in orbit” with our live-streamed Friday night service experience, even while following from afar. All of which is wonderful— yet, like being led around sidesaddle, it can feel like a largely passive experience, and is not by any objective means the same as being physically together.

That is what motivated our Congregational leadership to launch an online survey in mid-October to evaluate members' attitudes towards live gatherings. Our officers need information about their neighbors' aspirations, to help decide how and when to begin restoring public gatherings at our synagogue at such time in the (hopefully not-too-distant) future that ever-changing CDC guidelines— and the equally fluid pandemic curve, not just in Florida but here in Collier County— makes it credibly safe once again to do so.

In the meanwhile, starting this month we are adding a new personal dimension to our live-streamed Friday night Shabbat services. Using the same technology that allowed ‘*Aliyot*’ during our live-stream Rosh haShanah and Yom Kippur services, **JCMI members worshipping with us on-line from home on Friday nights will be live on our feed to do ritual honors** as part of that service: lighting the Shabbat candles, introducing *Qiddush*, and reading the Torah-blessing at our last-Friday-of-the-month Torah Shabbat. We want members of our JCMI family worshipping on-line be able to see and hear each other— however virtually— until we can all be together again in fact. [Contact the JCMI Office](#) to sign up for one of our pulpit honors on a future Friday night of your choice.

Many of us first learned to drive on a stick-shift manual transmission. Easing out the clutch pedal slowly, to avoid stalling the engine, and starting in a low gear in order to build up to a higher one, was a mechanical necessity, regardless of how fast or how far you will be going later on. That's certainly mixing metaphors, in terms of our earlier parable about riding horses sidesaddle. Nonetheless, it still demonstrates, both aptly and emphatically, that all of us at JCMI are moving forward together... with purpose, and with mutual commitment.

I love stories. I love non-fiction. I love fiction. I love the stories in the Bible. I love when the rabbi tells stories for or in his sermons. And now that we're back to the opening of Genesis, I'm having a great time. Adam and Eve. Okay, not so much the snake. Cain and Abel. Noah. All the peeps at Babel. And we're just at the beginning, mentioning only the leading men and ladies.

And the re-telling can never get old; we're reading about family. However, if you want to mix it up a bit, read more than one translation of the same parashah. There are numerous ones from which to choose and there are significant differences between them. If you're game, include my personal favorite, Richard Elliott Friedman's *Commentary on the Torah* (with a New English Translation and the Hebrew Text). And if you are intrigued by that, go to YouTube and listen to some of his interviews and lectures. He's brilliant and dedicated to making his writings accessible to us civilians, as well as meaningful to his fellow scholars.

But back to my point of storytelling and re-telling, have you ever watched a movie more than once and found points and facets you hadn't seen before? Of course. And did you regret it? I hope not. Personally, I'm more than happy to watch and re-watch Richard Burton's portrayal of Hamlet. In fact, I'd be more than happy to hear Rabbi Gross reprise his "story" sermons.

And even when we get to the parashiot – the stories – that list and/or count construction supplies, they are our only shots at "realistically" picturing the Ark or the Tabernacle.

Great stories. Great reads. Try 'em; you'll like 'em.



Our policy at JCMI is to offer members the choice of recording Yahrtseit dates in accordance with the English or Hebrew calendars.

If members choose to remember loved ones on their Yahrtseit using the English date of death, the Yahrtseit will be observed each year on the Friday Evening of the week in which that English date occurs.

If the Hebrew date is chosen, the Hebrew date falls on a different English date each year. The Yahrtseit will be observed each year on the Friday evening of the week when that Hebrew date occurs.

Please inform the office as to which date you observe the Yahrtseit of your loved one so that it can be properly recorded in our records. I hope this clarified and eliminates confusion about our policy.
