A Word Out-of-Season

Rabbi Gross is away from our community during the Summer months, and will return to the pulpit in time for S'lichot over the Labor Day weekend.

In the interim, he has asked us to share with our members a schtikeleh Toyre (“a little slice of Torah”) during this slow season.



An ancient Jewish folktale, teaching a lesson about a sense of proportion:

It happened once, in a far-away country long ago, that a pauper was so driven to desperation by his hunger and poverty that he stole a loaf of bread. Apprehended in the act, he was taken before the king and sentenced to death by hanging.

Bowing before the king in humble acceptance of this harsh decree, he begged: “I know a great secret, entrusted to me by my father, which I ask leave to divulge to the king and his court so it will not die with me. I know how to plant a pomegranate seed in the ground, in such a manner that it will grow into a mature tree and bear new fruit in the course of a single night.”

His imagination piqued by this great wonder, the king granted a stay of execution so that his court could witness the convicted criminal carry out this miraculous act. But after the thief had cleared an area in the royal garden and dug a hole, he looked up and declared: “the magic is dependent upon the integrity of its practitioner. For the wonder to occur, the seed can only be planted by a man who has never in his life stolen anything. I, being a convicted thief, can of course not do it.”

Unwilling to be thwarted from seeing the miracle, the king turned to his Prime Minister and handed the pomegranate seed to him. “I regret, your majesty, that once, as a young man, I kept for myself an article left with me for safe-keeping. That was a dishonest act, which disqualifies me from planting the seed.”

The royal Treasurer, offered the seed, put his hands behind his back. “Your Majesty, in dealing with the vast sums of your treasury, I may have at some time entered into the ledger a smaller amount than actually came in, and as such cannot claim to absolute probity in this matter.”

The king himself, still holding the seed, called to mind that he had himself once coveted and appropriated a jeweled ring belonging to his father.

Seeing his hesitation, and recognizing it for the confession it was, the emboldened thief turned to the king and his courtiers. “You are all wealthy and powerful persons, possessed of riches and influence beyond the imagination of mortal men— yet none of you is guiltless enough to plant this seed, while I, who stole only a little food, am to be hanged.”

The chastened king not only vacated the death-sentence against the thief, but in recognition of the man’s cleverness retained him as a royal advisor. And it is a matter of record that the former thief never hungered thereafter, and never had need to steal again.

Our policy at JCMI is to offer members the choice of recording Yahrtseit dates in accordance with the English or Hebrew calendars.

If members choose to remember loved ones on their Yahrtseit using the English date of death, the Yahrtseit will be observed each year on the Friday Evening of the week in which that English date occurs.

If the Hebrew date is chosen, the Hebrew date falls on a different English date each year. The Yahrtseit will be observed each year on the Friday evening of the week when that Hebrew date occurs.

Please inform the office as to which date you observe the Yahrtseit of your loved one so that it can be properly recorded in our records. I hope this clarified and eliminates confusion about our policy.
