VILLAGE OF SHERIDAN CROSS CONNECTION PROGRAM

At the regular meeting of the Common Council of the village of Sheridan, held on May 1, 1973, the following Ordinance was adopted.

An ordinance regulating cross connections with the public water supply system, i.e., a connection or arrangement of piping or appurtenances through which water of questionable quality, wastes or other contaminants can enter the public water supply system.

Be it ordained by the Village Council of Sheridar (State of Michigan ) ;

Section 1. That the Village adopts by reference the Water Supply Cross Connection Rules of the Michigan Dept. of Public Health being R 325.431 to R 325 440 of the Michigan Administrative Code.

Section 2. That it shall be the duty of the Village Superintendent to cause inspections to be made of all properties served by the public water supply where cross connections with the public water supply is deemed possible. The frequency of inspections and reinspections based on potential health hazards involved shall be as established by the Village of Sheridan and as approved by the Michigan Dept. of Public Health.

Section 3. That the Village Superintendent shall have the right to enter at any reasonable time any property served by a connection to the public water supply system of the Village of Sheridan for inspecting the piping system or systems thereof for cross connections. On request of the owner, lessees, or occupants of any property so served shall furnish to the inspection agency any pertinent information regarding the piping system or systems thereof on such property. The refusal of access, when requested, shall be deemed evidence of the presence of cross connections.

Section 4. That the Village of Sheridan is hereby authorized and directed to discontinue water service after reasonable notice to any property wherein any connection in violation of this ordinance exists, and to take such other precautionary measures deemed necessary to eliminate any danger of contamination of the public water supply system. Water service to such property shall not be restored until the cross connection(s) has been eliminated in compliance with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 5. That the potable water supply made available on the properties served by the public water supply shall be protected from possible contamination as specified by this ordinance and by the State and Village of Sheridan plumbing code. Any water outlet which could be used for potable or domestic purposes and which is not supplied by the system must be labeled in a conspicuous manner as:

WATER UNSAFE FOR DRINKING

Section 6. That this ordinance does not supercede the state plumbing code or any village or township code, but is supplementary to them.

Section 7. That any person or customer found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance, or any written order thereof, of the Village of Sheridan, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than (5.00) nor more than (\$25.00) per violation. Each day upon which a violation of the provisions of this act shall occur shall be deemed a separate and additional violation for the purpose of this ordinance.

This ordinance is in accordance and compliance with the rules and policy of the Michigan Dept. of Public Health.
