Trustee McDougall MOVED: To accept the agenda as presented, Trustee Wyckoff-McFarland supported. Motion approved.

Trustee Wagner MOVED: To approve the minutes of the November 14th, 2023, regular meeting, Trustee Edelman supported. Motion approved.

Trustee McDougall MOVED: To approve the paid bills as of December 7th, 2023, Trustee Everingham supported. Motion approved.

Trustee Wagner MOVED: To approve the treasurer's report ending December 7th, 2023, Trustee Everingham supported. Motion approved.

Ed Lingeman-Village Superintendent: Reported the enclosed trailer is still in the works. Ed also mentioned he had been approached by an individual regarding the Carnation property, he requested the property/ordinance committee meet with the individual.

New Business:

Shane Petersen-Flies and Vandenbrink: Discussed infrastructure updates and what would be updated with the project, this project will need to be completed by 2026.

Andy Campbell-Baker/Tilly: Discussed a Grant offered by EGLE to disparaged (over-burdened) communities, the grant offers .50 cents on the dollar and is a 7.97-million-dollar project. This is the last year the grant will be offered, and the village will need to obtain the rest of the funding.

Trustee Wagner MOVED: to move forward with this project and accept the grant. Trustee McDougall supported. Trustee Sisson voted Nay on this motion. Motion approved.

Trustee Edelman discussed that CMHS wishes to use our poles downtown to showcase graduates, he will reach out to see about coordination of this project.

Trustee McDougall MOVED: To adjourn council meeting. Trustee Sisson supported. Motion passed.
