Board of Governors Meeting Minutes

August 25, 2026 – 10:03 AM

Opening

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Diamond at 10:03 AM. The Board recited the **Pledge of Allegiance**, followed by a moment of silence in honor of deceased members and those currently experiencing illness.

1. Approval of Minutes

Secretary Giudice read the minutes of the July 28, 2026, Board meeting. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Mr. Giudice, seconded by Mr. Tenaglia, and approved unanimously.

2. Financial Report

Due to the absence of Treasurer Mr. Coburn, President Feilich presented the current financial report. The Club's current bank balance is **\$15,118.64**. (See Attached)

The detailed financial report is attached to the official minutes.

3. Constitution, By-Laws & Rules

President Feilich reported that there will be **five vacancies** on the current Board of Governors that will need to be addressed during this year's election.

A discussion followed regarding the appropriate method for filling the vacancies. Mr. Tenaglia suggested reducing the size of the Board.

Mr. Giudice moved that the Board of Directors be reduced to **ten delegates**. Mr. Katz seconded the motion. The recommendation will be presented to the membership for consideration and approval, consistent with the Club's Constitution.

4. Tournaments & Outings

Mr. Aiello presented a report on the **August 3 outing at Crab Meadow Golf Course**.

He reported that **47 golfers participated**, out of the 48 members who had signed up. The event generated a preliminary profit of **\$267.16**, although some minor outstanding issues could affect the final amount. (See Attached)

The **50/50 raffle generated \$260** for the Club.

5. Old Business

President Feilich reopened the discussion regarding the ongoing issue of **slow play**.

One contributing factor discussed was the amount of time players spend searching for lost golf balls. Mr. Bass offered to donate golf balls to the Club so that players will have replacement balls available and can adhere to the **three-minute rule** for searching for a lost ball without concern about being left without a replacement.

Another suggestion was to compile a list of players who have consistently contributed to slow play and remind them of the Club's rules regarding completing a round within the **4½-hour time frame**.

The Board discussed the importance of addressing slow play while maintaining an enjoyable experience for all members.

6. New Business

President Feilich opened the discussion regarding **membership dues for 2027**.

After discussion, it was unanimously determined that the annual membership dues for 2027 will be increased to **\$175**, with a **\$25 late-payment penalty**.

President Feilich also presented the **2027 schedule of events**, which is attached to the official minutes. (See Attached)

7. Adjournment

A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Katz, seconded by Mr. Modifica, and approved unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at **11:59 AM**.
