Board of Governors Meeting Minutes

May 26, 2026 – 10:00 AM

Opening

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Diamond at 10:00 AM. The Board recited the **Pledge of Allegiance**, followed by a moment of silence honoring deceased members and those currently ill.

1. Minutes Approval

Secretary Mr. Giudice read the minutes from the April 28 meeting. A motion to accept the minutes was made by Mr. Giudice, seconded by Mr. Pirone, and approved unanimously.

2. Financial Report

Mr. Coburn reported a bank balance of \$12,003.01 as of May 26, 2026. A detailed financial statement is attached to the official minutes.

3. Constitution, By-Laws & Rules

Mr. Schultheiss was absent; no report was submitted.

4. Tournaments & Outings

Mr. Wolf presented an update on the July 16 Outing at Crab Meadow Golf Course:

- Crab Meadow requires a 48-player commitment and a **\$500 deposit**.
- The Club currently has 44 confirmed players, with 3 additional women considering participation.
- Discussion focused on the risk of falling short of the required minimum and possible mitigation strategies, including adjusting prize money or increasing the outing fee (currently \$160).
- After deliberation, the Board agreed to proceed with the outing, submit the \$500 deposit, and continue efforts to secure additional players.

5. Old Business

Championship Qualification Rounds

Mr. Feilich addressed criticism regarding the inclusion of September–October 2025 rounds toward the ten-round championship eligibility requirement. He reaffirmed that the rule ensures fairness for members who spend early spring months in Florida or face weather-related cancellations.

Clearview Pace-of-Play Concerns

Clearview management expressed concerns about slow play affecting scheduled outings. Although no players were removed, Mr. Feilich will:

- Ensure 7:00 AM tee-offs with 6:30 AM check-in
- Meet with the Clearview GM
- Accept Ms. Kim’s offer to schedule alternative courses when Clearview is unavailable, pending Club approval

Alternative Play Days

Mr. Tobacco suggested using Thursdays as an alternate play day when Clearview is unavailable. Mr. Feilich will explore this option.

Shotgun Start Payments

Mr. Coburn announced that advance payment for shotgun starts is discontinued. Players will now pay on the day of play.

6. New Business

Group Photo – June 3

A Club group photo will be taken prior to the June 3 Shotgun Start. Mr. Wade and Mr. Tenaglia will coordinate.

CTP Sign Collection

Mr. Gallagher requested clarification on collecting Clos an est-to-the-Pin (CTP) signs during shotgun events. He will obtain a golf cart after play d collect the signs himself.

America's 250th Celebration – September Outing

Mr. Giudice proposed incorporating America's 250th Anniversary into the September outing. Mr. Coburn and Mr. Giudice will collaborate on a flyer and sponsorship program to honor the milestone.

7. Adjournment

A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Diamond, seconded by Mr. Pirone, and approved unanimously. The meeting concluded at 10:53 AM.
