

**Clearview Seniors Golf Club Board of Governors
Minutes of the Meeting held April 28, 2026.**

Call to Order

George Diamond called the meeting to order at 10:00 AM at Mr. Diamond's House. The meeting began with the Board members reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. A moment of silence was observed to honor all past deceased members and those who are ill.

Minutes

Secretary Giudice read the minutes from the March 31st Board Meeting. A motion to accept the minutes was proposed by Secretary Giudice, seconded by Mr. Katz, and passed by the Board.

Financial Report

Mr. Coburn reported that the Club's bank balance as of March 31 was \$11,275. After accounting for income and expenses during April, the balance as of April 28, 2026, stands at \$10,243.83. Replacement checks for lost dues payments from 2025 will increase the Club's balance by \$450, bringing the total to \$10,693.83.

Constitution, By-Laws, and Rules

Mr. Schultheiss was absent and no report was available.

Tournaments and Outings

Mr. Aiello discussed alternatives to holding the outing at Spook Rock, specifically the Crab Meadow Golf Course. This venue is more cost-effective, offers varied food options, and eliminates tolls for travel. Crab Meadow is located off Exit 53 in Long Island, and members can carpool to utilize HOV lanes. Mr. Aiello presented three golf and food options ranging from \$109 to \$142 per person (see attached sheet). Outings are available on Mondays and Wednesdays, with tee times at 7:30 AM and 1:30 PM. Mr. Aiello proposed a July date and was authorized by the Board to contact Crab Meadow for available dates.

Old Business

Mr. Modifico expressed the need for an improved process to notify Club members about rain cancellations. The President stated that email addresses have been corrected to ensure proper notifications in the future.

Mr. Tobacco followed up on whether Mr. Feilich had sent a request for a volunteer Club Photographer. Mr. Feilich replied that he had not, but will send an email, and if no one volunteers he will accept the position.

Mr. Tobacco also inquired if Mr. Aiello submitted a flyer to attract new members. Mr. Aiello confirmed submission but has not received feedback or suggestions. President Feilich will investigate.

Mr. Diamond requested acknowledgment and noted that some criticism of Clearview management is unjust. He emphasized the need for the Clearview Manager to operate profitably and praised improvements to the Clearview golf course. Mr. Diamond urged members to be more flexible and understanding of the business challenges faced by Clearview Golf Park, while still advocating for Club support.

New Business

President Feilich announced that the May 27th golf event will be held at Forest Park, with tee time starting at 7:00 AM.

Mr. Feilich also reported that Clearview has agreed to allow Club members to walk on Modified Shot Gun Dates.

1. Members must record the start and end time on their score cards.
2. Members must notify the Club by Sunday if they need to cancel.
3. Players must check in 30 minutes before their tee time.
4. Players are reminded that late cancellations may result in charges to the Club, which will be imposed on the violating individual.

Mr. Coburn outlined the process for handling payments on Modified Shot Gun dates. The Club will make a single payment for all participating members, and Mr. Coburn will notify members that fees must be paid one week ahead of play. Multiple payment methods will be available, and those with gift cards will pay individually.

Adjournment

Mr. Katz moved to adjourn the meeting, Mr. Pirone seconded the motion, and members voted in favor. The meeting ended at 10:57 AM.
