

**Clearview Seniors Golf Club General Membership Meeting  
Minutes of the Meeting held March 25, 2026.**

George Diamond called the meeting to order at 10:02 AM at Clearview Golf Park.

The meeting began with the members reciting “The Pledge of Allegiance”, and a moment of silence was observed to honor all past deceased members and those members who are ill. Special note was made of the passing of Joe Paesano, golf ranger at Clearview Golf Course.

**Opening:**

President opened his remarks stating that there will be 10 Modified Shot Gun starts for the Club this season. In addition, Closest to the Pin will include all four par 3 holes with only one winning player in each of the red and white tees. The winner must be within 25 ft. but will not need to par the hole.

**Constitution & By-Laws**

Mr. Schultheiss stated that in 2026 he does not see a need to make any changes to the Constitution and By-Laws, however if a member identifies a need for a change or addition, he should report the issue to Mr. Schultheiss.

**Financial Report:**

Mr. Coburn reported that the current financial balance for the Club stands at \$11,000. There have been members that have reported that payments of their dues had been made, but Mr. Coburn does not have supporting bank records for the payments. Mr. Coburn will conduct an audit to determine if all the bank recording receipts show payments by the affected members. He also asked that the members review their checking accounts and determine if their checks were cashed. Mr. Bass suggested that notification be made to every member when they are in arrears. Mr. Coburn agreed to that idea and further stated that written receipts will be provided to the dues paying member supporting their payments.

Mr. Coburn stated that the Club Financials are in good shape and expect generous prize monies for competitive Club events. He once again emphasized the importance of raising sponsorship monies to help maintain the solvency of the Club. Mr. Giudice asked that all the members print out the new member flyer and place them in the commercial establishments they frequent. Mr Wolf objected to the referenced flyer stating that we should use a picture of our Club instead of a manufactured picture and should include African Americans to show the diversity of the Club.

**Tournaments and Outings:**

Mr. Aiello made an in-depth presentation of the Tournament and Outing events for the season noting the location and prize monies involved. Mr. Aiello handed out a sheet describing the events for each member to review. Of note, President Feilich raised the prize money for or Closest to the Pin to \$10 instead of \$5. See the attached Report for Mr. Aiello’s work. Mr. Katz asked how the schedule will be formulated for the April 1 play. Mr. Aiello will send emails requesting participation for April 1 and then create a member schedule for tee times.

**Old Business:**

There was a discussion of when to hold the Awards Luncheon. A suggestion was made to change the event to a dinner on day separate from the normal golf day. A vote was taken and it was unanimous to keep the Luncheon after our normal golf day.

**New Business:**

Based on a question by Mr. Potksis regarding play on May 27, President Feilich stated that the management of Clearview notified the Club that the entire Clearview Course is reserved that day and our Club will need to play at another site. President Feilich will go to Forest Park this PM and attempt to arrange play for that day.

Mr. Weiss suggested that the Club allow member discretion to change their assigned tees and play on a different tee provided they notify the Club in advance. A lengthy discussion ensued with members concerned it would provide a possible advantage to their flight standings. Mr. Weiss noted that the handicaps would adjust the play and no member would benefit. Other members indicated that it would cause confusion and mistakes. It was put to a voter and the suggestion was defeated by an overwhelming vote. Therefore, once you decide on what tees you choose in the beginning of the year you must adhere to your assigned tee location.

**Adjourn:**

Mr. Katz moved to adjourn the meeting, Mr. Diamond seconded the motion, and the members voted in favor. The Meeting ended at 11:15AM.
