

**Clearview Seniors Golf Club Board of Governors
Minutes of the Meeting held March 31, 2026.**

George Diamond called the meeting to order at 10:01 AM at Mr. Diamond's House.

The meeting began with the Board members reciting "The Pledge of Allegiance", and a moment of silence was observed to honor all past deceased members and those members who are ill.

Minutes:

Secretary Giudice read the minutes from the September 30th Board Meeting and moved to accept the Minutes, Mr. Katz seconded the motion and the motion passed.

Financial Report:

Mr. Coburn reported that the Club's starting balance for 2026 is \$12,700. In 2025, the starting balance was \$12, 869. Since this year we are not incurring the 2025 expenses of \$2000 related to the 50th Anniversary celebration the Club will be in a better financial position. The Club in 2026 will increase the prize monies for the Club's competitive events, specifically CTPP will be \$10, Birdies \$10 and Low Net by Flights \$10.

Mr. Coburn explained that after exhaustive auditing and research the reason for the lost checks for dues for 10 of the Club's members had to do with a particular envelope delivered by Mr. Feilich to the doorman at Mr. Coburn's home that never reached him. He stated that he will be delivering a letter to the 10 members that claimed to have paid their dues and explain the error and request a replacement check.

Constitution & By-Laws & Rules

Mr. Schultheiss stated that 2026 will be an official year to change or amend the By-Laws. He said that the 8 round qualification rule for eligibility for championship play will need to be changed to 10 rounds. Also, Mr. Schultheiss suggested to eliminate the current rule governing type of play for Championship competition since in past years "play" varied between match play and net scoring. Mr. Schultheiss proposal is to include a statement that the decision for the type of play will be made at the start of the Season.

Tournaments & Outings:

Mr. Aiello mentioned that he had distributed the proposed 2026 events for Tournaments and Outings at the General Membership Meeting and if anyone needs another copy to see him.

Mr. Aiello had phoned Spook Rock to finalize our June Outing, however he has not received a return call. He will be following up.

The rules for CTPP this year will be on each hole and there will be one winner from the group playing from the White Tees and one from the Red Tees. The rule for being within 25' of the hole is eliminated along with the requirement that you must par the hole.

Old Business:

President Feilich reminded the Board that there will be 9 dates that a modified shot gun start will be in effect. The Clearview rule that all players must ride is subject to further clarification. Mr. Diamond has had conversation with Jayson, the Regional Manager, and voiced his displeasure with the rule that no-one can walk when Modified Shot Gun days are in effect. Jayson will take it under advisement. The question of only having a single payment from the Club on Shot Gun starts was challenged. A meeting will be set-up with the Clearview Manager to negotiate the contract and challenge some of the items in the contract including the set-up procedures for play on Shot Gun starts and the food service associated with our September Outing.

President Feilich outlined the plans for May 27, the day our Club cannot play at Clearview. He mentioned that on May 27 arrangements have been secured to play at the Forest Park Course with a beginning tee time of 7 AM.

Mr. Katz noted that no action has been implemented to obtain a photographer for the Club. President Feilich will send out a notice to all members asking for a volunteer to become the Club's photographer.

New Business:

Mr. Aiello submitted a proposal for a new membership flyer. He stated that the flyer will include the important advantages for joining our Club. Changes can be made to further enhance the flyer but should serve as the basis for the promotion.

Adjourn

Mr. Diamond moved to adjourn the meeting, Mr. Katz seconded the motion, and the members voted in favor. The Meeting ended at 10:45AM.
