

HOW CAN YOU SPOT IF SOMEONE MAY BE VULNERABLE AND BEING **EXPLOITED** OR **TRAFFICKED**?

There are various **key indicators** to look for:

- Children who are alone and look frightened or distressed.
- Children who look uncomfortable in adult company.
- Children/adults loitering around changing rooms/toilet facilities.
- Dishevelled and unkempt appearances.
- Who are those not interested in the sporting event/occasion.
- Children and young people accessing prohibited areas.
- Out of ordinary behaviour in car parking areas.

ONE SIGN ON ITS OWN DOES NOT MEAN SOMEONE HAS BEEN SEXUALLY EXPLOITED OR TRAFFICKED, BUT SEVERAL SIGNS TOGETHER SHOULD GIVE YOU CAUSE FOR CONCERN.
