



COVID PROTOCOLS: MAJOR LEAGUE SPORTSPLEX

Modified to RED Zone for Toronto

We have taken enhanced health and safety measures to protect our guests:

- **Max 10 people allowed per room at all times, including coaches ;**
- Additional cleaning and sanitization processes and elements have been added to cover all areas.
- Hand Sanitisation stations at the entrance of the dome.
- ***TURF will be disinfected sprayed at the end of the day***
- Electrostatic sprayers have been deployed to ensure the disinfecting operations achieved highest disinfection levels.
- All waiting areas and On field fixtures will be sanitised between rentals
- Signage and reminders for personal hygiene and handwashing have been placed throughout the facility, including all restrooms.
- Increased sanitization of public touch points, picnic tables, handrails and doorknobs.
- New temporary washrooms installed to avoid visits in the main buildings.
- Washrooms will be cleaned and disinfected every hour.
- All MLS Dome staff will be required to do a daily COVID-19 Screening
- However, there is an inherent risk of exposure to COVID -19 in any public place where people are present.
- COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death.
- According to local health authorities, senior citizens and guests with underlying medical conditions are especially vulnerable.
- By entering the venue, you voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19, and Major League Sportsplex disclaims any and all liability related thereto.

Anyone coming to the Major League sportsplex must take reasonable precaution before arriving at the facility. You should not be entering the facility if you have:

- Fever (temperature greater than 37.6°C)
- New or worsening cough
- Shortness of breath or trouble breathing
- Sore throat, different from seasonal allergies
- New loss of smell and/or taste
- Diarrhea or vomiting



COVID 19: Extract from the COVID Safety Pan : For Customer Distribution

- Been in close contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID19 in the last 14 days
- Traveled internationally in the last 14 days
- If you are considered vulnerable or “at risk” (elderly individuals, immunosuppressed persons and/or individuals suffering from serious health problems)

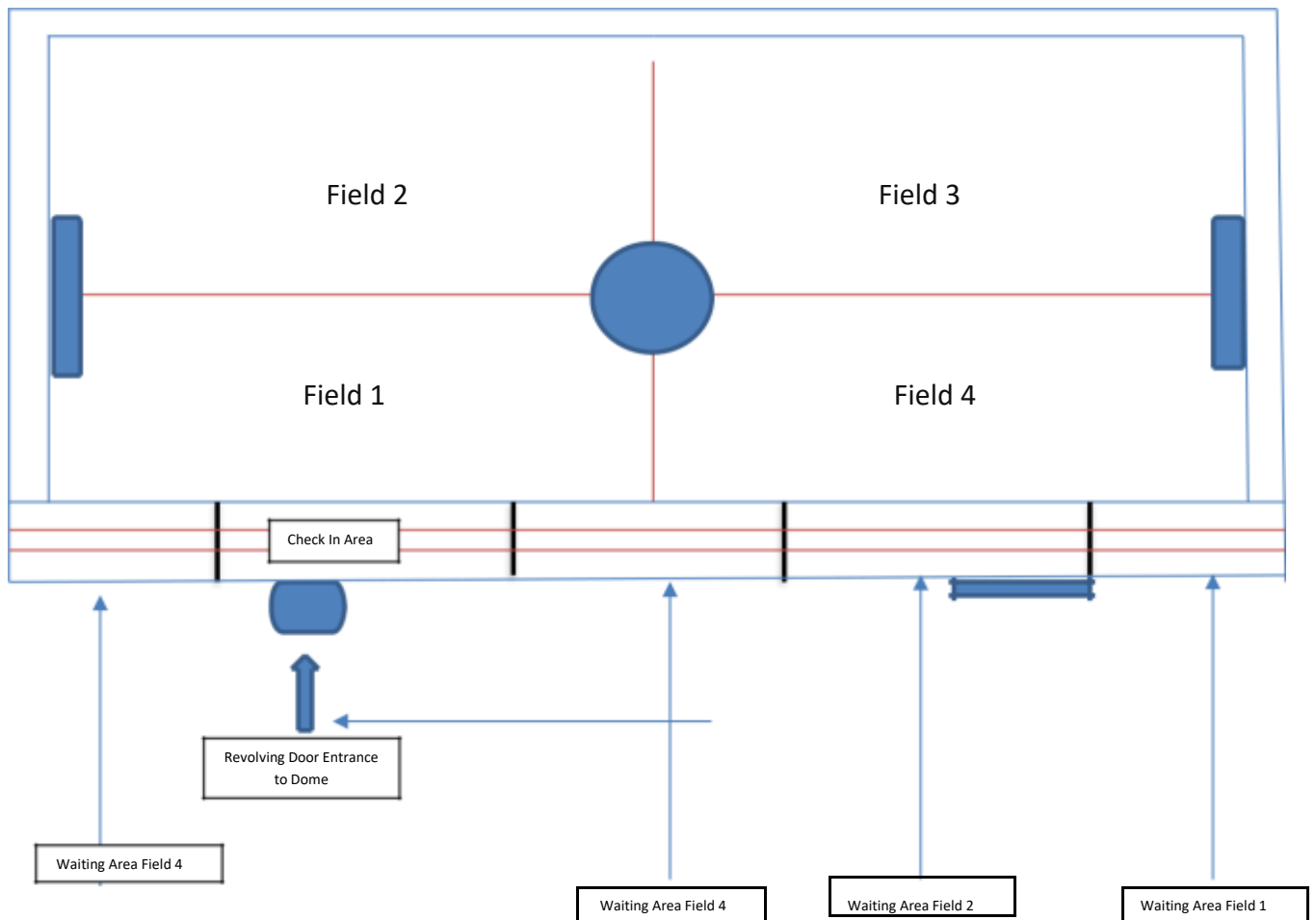
Face Mask:

- Face masks are mandatory for all participants while they are not on field.
- No entry is allowed in the dome, if participants are not wearing face masks.
- If any participant cannot wear face mask for any reason, then they will not be allowed entry in the dome.
- At the end of the session, when participants get off the field, they will wear the mask immediately.
- While participants are in the waiting area, they will be required to wear face masks.

New Infrastructure created for COVID -19:

- New partition installed along the dome to create separated space from the main field.
- Partition is 30 feet high, to protect against any stray ball coming over.
- New 12 ft by 20 ft steel structure.
- New temporary two gender neutral heated and flushable washrooms in the steel structure to provide washroom facilities for dome participants.
- Full time staff hired to run the COVID protocols and enhanced cleaning protocols.
- Two new hand sanitising stations at the check in area.
- Electrostatic sprayers to achieve the highest possible disinfecting.

Check In Procedure:



Please follow the following protocols.

They have been created to provide an environment which will minimise the risk of spread of COVID 19

We have implemented these protocols for your safety, and to help us keep operating the facility.

Entering Protocols:

1. Dome entrance revolving door will be opened for check in 15 mins before the start of the session.
2. There will always be a staff at the check in desk for check in.
3. Because there is one entry and exit door, **only one person is allowed in the revolving door at the time.**
4. **Participant exiting the dome will have priority of movement, participants entering should yield to participants exiting the dome through revolving door.**
5. **Participants in the waiting area will remain in the waiting area, till such time a final buzzer is sounded and all clear given to move to the fields.**
6. **Please follow arrow signs to move from waiting area to the fields.**
7. Any participant / group not following the above will be asked to leave the facility and or charged for the extra time, permit cancelled, and any payments made withheld.
8. All groups will have their designated field assigned before arriving at the dome, this is extremely important to ensure that required social distancing is maintained.
9. Designated waiting areas for each field have been created, separated from the main field by partition.
10. Each waiting area will have 18, 6ft by 6ft social distancing boxes, painted on turf, and one box will be for one participant.
11. Max 10 people are allowed / room including coaches.
12. While in the waiting area, wearing of face mask is mandatory.
13. Any participant who cannot wear mask for any reason will not be allowed to enter the dome.
14. Participants will be checked in the checking area at the entrance and guided to the designated waiting area.
15. Temperature screening may be conducted at this time.
16. Parents and spectators are strictly not allowed in the dome.
17. All organisers will provide a contact tracing sheet as per prescribed format for contact tracing purposes.



ON Field Protocols

1. DO not enter the field while it is occupied by other participants not from your group.
2. Follow the exit arrow signs to leave the building.
3. DO NOT spit on turf.
4. DO NOT blow your nose without a tissue or paper towel
5. DO NOT remove any equipment.
6. Do not throw garbage on the turf.
7. No Food or drinks other than water bottle allowed.
8. DO NOT touch any equipment (ex. Cones) unless instructed to do so by a coach.
9. Label water bottles clearly with participant's name and leave water bottle in designate area.
10. Face masks are mandatory for all participants while they are NOT on field.
11. No entry is allowed in the dome, if participants are not wearing face masks.
12. If any participant cannot wear face mask for any reason, then they will not be allowed entry in the dome.
13. At the end of the session, when participants get off the field, they will wear the mask immediately.
14. While participants are in the waiting area, they will be required to wear face masks.



Exiting Protocols :

1. 10 mins before the end of the session, buzzer will be sounded, At this time all on field activity should start to wind down.
2. 5 mins before the end of the session, a second buzzer will be sounded, at time, participants should start leaving the dome.
3. Please do not wait, linger, hold discussions, dress / undress after the second buzzer.
4. Please gather all your belonging and leave the dome immediately after the second buzzer.
5. Any participant / group not following the above will be asked to leave the facility and or charged for the extra time, permit cancelled, and any payments made withheld.
6. Temporary washroom facility have been created along the walkway.
7. **Entry into the main building is strictly prohibited.**
8. **Participants will leave the dome and parking immediately at the end of the session, loitering around the parking is strictly prohibited.**

MASK OR FACE COVERING REQUIRED

All persons entering or remaining in these premises shall wear a mask or face covering which covers the nose, mouth and chin as required under City of Toronto by-law no. 541-2020.



Exceptions include people who cannot wear a mask for medical reasons, or children under two years old, or those who require accommodation in accordance with the Ontario Human Rights Code. Proof of a medical condition is not required.

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HOW TO WEAR A CLOTH MASK



- ✓ Do wash your hands before putting it on and taking it off
- ✓ Do make sure it fits comfortably over mouth and nose for easy breathing
- ✓ Do wash your cloth mask after each use in the laundry
- ✓ Do clean surfaces that a dirty mask touches
- ✗ Don't touch your face or mask while using it
- ✗ Don't use masks on children under 2 or those who can't breathe with them on
- ✗ Don't share your mask with others
- ✗ Don't wear medical masks. Keep them for health-care workers.

You still need to:



Keep a 2m distance



Wash hands often

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WHY SHOULD I WEAR A CLOTH MASK?



- ✓ Protects others from your germs
- ✓ Required in indoor public spaces under City of Toronto By-Law 541-2020
- ✓ Be respectful of people who can't wear masks for medical reasons
- ✗ Don't give to children under the age of two
- ✗ Don't give to people with trouble breathing
- ✗ Don't use medical masks. Keep them for front-line workers.

We still need to stay 6 feet (2 metres) apart and wash our hands often.

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
