CHAPTER BOARD MEMBER

According to Chapter Bylaws, a certain number of members are elected as board members-at-large. A board member-at-large is a vital link or liaison to chapter members and can bring to board meetings the members concerns. This is an elected position to assure that the members' needs are being addressed.

The position is also a training ground for future chapter officers through committee appointments, audit committee, show committee, chorus manager, membership committee or corresponding secretary. These added responsibilities provide the Chapter President with better control of overall chapter operations.

There's also the benefit of keeping previous officers active in the chapter through this position. These members have historic perspective which adds a touch of expertise to the Board of Directors.

There is little question of the versatility of the Board member-at-large position providing the experience, the training ground and the communication link to better Chapter administration.
