You can register on-line or you may call the front desk at (952) 854-2100 (Press '0' and ask for the Fall Convention Rate). Make sure you request the \$95 Barbershop convention rate. There is a second link for the Embassy Suites (next door to the MSP Hilton) with a rate of (\$139 per night)
- 3. HOLD ON TO HOPE "Hold On To Hope" is the theme song for the convention. Download your learning tracks and the sheet music for this inspirational song. It will be one of the featured selections of the All Chapter Chorus and a sing along for the weekend.
- 4. CONTEST AND FESTIVAL REGISTRATION There is a new link and a Contest and Festival registration webpage that is now open. You must click on this link to register your chorus or quartet to cross the judges stage and be evaluated. And remember all members of your chorus or quartet must also register for the convention. Contest and Festival registrations must be completed NLT September 15th!



Chapter Show Clearance Update Submitted by Bob Brey, District Secretary

Since Land O' Lakes District held its Leadership Training Academy last January, Society has updated many forms and requirements for chapter show clearances.

Starting with the American chapters, a new BMI/SESAC form has been developed. The form is a printable or PDF fillable version which should be downloaded to your computer, saved, completed and sent to the District Secretary. A new fee schedule has been instituted and most chapters will pay the minimum \$50 per show performed. The instructions also now say to send ONE copy to your District Secretary. Yes, you can print, sign and mail the form but it is so much easier to type in your chapter secretary name, chapter name, date and then email the copy to the DS. The annual ASCAP form has been updated and has a complete set of instructions and FAQ's. This form is emailed or mailed directly to Society offices.

Canadian chapters will now use a simplified SOCAN show clearance application form. Page one of the fillable PDF is emailed or mailed to the DS, who signs and returns a copy. After the performance(s) have occurred Canadian chapters complete page two of the form and download and complete the 2022SOCAN/Entandem report form as an Excel spreadsheet. There is a separate set of instructions for completing and paying the fees available.

All the various forms you need for show clearances may be found in the document center on member's only part of Society's website. Or since this is (for many of you) an electronic version follow the included link:

As always continue to complete the show clearance forms so all chapters remain in copyright clearance. This ensures that you, the District and Society do not end up in a copyright infringement court case.



2022 Fall Contest is Open for Registration Submitted by Peter Maddeaux Director of Contests and Judging

Greetings Singers!

The time is upon us to gather for the Land O' Lakes 2022 Fall International Prelims and Chorus Convention/Contests. This convention will be held on October 14th and 15th, 2022 at the Minneapolis Airport Hilton (same as last year).

The LOL Webpage (loldistrict.org) has all of the information available for registering for the convention.

IMPORTANT

Quartets:

We will have an International quartet prelim (2 rounds) which includes registered male, female and mixed quartets. We will also have contests for the District, Male, Female and Mixed awards for Quartets (2 rounds). Since the District contests are 2 rounds, all quartets should be prepared to sing 4 songs. When entering the Gender-related contests, the quartet is automatically entered into the District (2 round) contest and is eligible for the District Championship. It is strictly your responsibility to enter song information in Member Center. I am not authorized as the DRCJ to assist in this area.

Choruses:

We will also have contests for the District, Male, Female and Mixed awards for Choruses (Single Round). When entering the gender-related contests, the entity is automatically entered into the District Contest.

The Most Improved Chorus award will be based on Chorus scores from last fall's contest, will be calculated by BHS Formula, but require an increased score over last Fall's scores.

Festival Entrants:

There are 2 types of Festival Entrants...Members of both must hold convention registrations.

- Contest Festival Units (must be members of the society) that are singing two songs for score and eval only (scores not to be announced). The songs do not need to be contestable.
- 2. Non-Contest Festival Units (Sing during non-Contest times) for fun; no BHS memberships required. Songs do not need to be contestable...Good taste is necessary.

If you are not a BHS member or a registered quartet that wants to perform 2 songs with the potential of a score and/or evaluation, please contact me directly by phone (preferred) and/or email to confirm your interest. We would still like to provide the opportunity for you to sing and possibly receive an evaluation/coaching session, if desired. Just contact me.

We will also offer a score-only session invitational for all choruses (Men's, Women's, Mixed, Seniors) who do not wish to compete, but would like to receive a score.

Because of the new Member Center requirements, no performers can be entered through the contest system if they are not BHS members, non-registered quartet members, or are not singing with an LOL chapter registered with the BHS. They cannot be officially entered into the evaluation/judging session following the contest sessions or be "officially" scored. However, depending on the numbers of competitors who sign up, and how many non-BHS performers request to sing on stage, I will do my best to obtain an "Unofficial" score from the judges and will look into a potential evaluation/coaching session. This will also include any novice quartets, seniors quartets, women's quartets mixed choruses or womens' choruses, who are not registered. 


