All 450 of us who were able to participate in our 2021 Fall Convention had a great time. And very importantly, we had no known cases of Covid transmission from our event.


Congratulations to Double Dutch, winners of the mixed quartet division, Loose Change our







2021 Roar Back Convention Survey Results Submitted by Arv Zenk


We've compiled the results of your survey from the 2021 Roar Back convention. The survey confirms that we had a weekend packed with great performances, fun activities, and a superb Showcase Dinner. We are so glad that so many of you thoroughly enjoyed our time together and thank you for providing feedback for future conventions. The following is a brief summary of the weekend and what you told us about your experience:


- There were 449 registrations/tickets for the convention with 202 people attending the Showcase Dinner. We had 13 quartets and 9 choruses with a total of 223 contestants crossing the contest stage.
- The survey was sent to 256 e-mail addresses (only a single address was available for most couples and some quartets). We had 124 responses (48% response rate) to the survey and only 1 possible COVID response from a person who had a bad cold.
- Convention Location, Hotel, and Communication received very positive reviews.
- The Showcase Dinner and Fun Squad activities also received many positive reviews
- Many would recommend that others attend future conventions.
- Take a look at the attached charts/graphs which summarize your inputs.


We also collected 56 comments in this survey covering a variety of topics, compliments, and concerns. Some comments went into great detail and provided specific recommendations which will be very helpful in planning our next convention. For those who completed the survey, thank you for your feedback. For everyone who attended - Thank you for sharing your weekend with us!


