Rules and Regulations for dogs and owners hiking the Canine Camino trail

- 1. All dogs must be on a leash and under control at all times while on the trail. This is to ensure the safety of other hikers, wildlife, and the dog itself.
- 2. Owners must clean up after their dogs and properly dispose of their waste. This is to maintain the cleanliness of the trail and prevent the spread of disease.
- 3. Dogs must be well-behaved and not aggressive towards other dogs or people. Any dogs displaying aggressive behavior may be asked to leave the trail.
- 4. Owners must carry enough water for themselves and their dogs, as there may not be access to water along the trail.
- 5. Dogs must be up to date on their vaccinations and have a valid rabies certificate.
- 6. Dogs must not disturb or harm any wildlife or plants along the trail. Owners must keep their dogs away from any sensitive areas or habitats.
