#### **Building Influence**

"Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain." 1 Corinthians 15:58

Imagine God puts on the table before you a blueprint of His plan and purpose for your life. With that blueprint includes all of the hardships, trials, tribulations, disappointments, and challenges that must be endured for you to get where God wants to take you.

You can choose to open the blueprint or you can choose to live your current life as you please. Many of us want to know God's plan and purpose for our lives and so most of us would probably choose to open the blueprint. The catch is that opening the blue print exposes the cost.

God's plan and purpose for our lives is greater than anything we can imagine. If each of us knew exactly what God had in store for us there'd be no hesitation to want what God desires, until we see the cost required to get there.

Following Jesus costs us our lives. No other decision will ever be as difficult as walking with the Lord. Abounding in the work of the Lord requires sacrifice, commitment, devotion, and steadfastness towards the Father. All of the disciples would eventually die for choosing to follow Jesus.

What the Lord has shown me recently is that we are in a season of building influence. We may not always see or understand what's happening but be rest assured that when we show up in the name of Jesus to the glory of God no work is in vain.

When I was formally serving at Saddleback Church in California, we always talked about three aspects of every good leader. Every good leader builds influence, develops leaders, and produces results. Jesus was the greatest most influence leader ever to exist.

All authority on heaven and earth was His yet He led not out of authority but out of influence. People were captivated by Jesus because when people had an encounter with Him, they had an encounter with God that changed everything. The King of all kings demanded no one to serve Him. Jesus didn't come to be served He came to serve. We show up every week with hearts to serve.

We've seen God building influence with the kids, with parents, with management at the apartments, with churches, businesses, individuals, and non-profits. God's building influence with volunteers and their families and even onlookers who aren't directly involved but hear about and see what's happening in the community.

There are no words to describe the influence that has taken place within these kid's hearts as they are completely different people from when we started earlier this year. God has given each of us influence in some regard. The question is what or who are we influencing people too? Labor will never be in vain if we are influencing people to Jesus.
