Moments of Glory

Most of the children we serve live in single family homes. Mothers are often the primary caretakers and providers of the children. This isn't always the case but often fathers are absent for one reason or another.

Some of them are out getting drunk and high. Some of them have been locked up because of bad choices they've made. Some of them simply abandoned their children and families. Many of our children haven't even met their fathers.

A couple weeks prior to camp a father joined us with his children, he just moved into the apartments. After the message, in tears, he responded to the Gospel and professed faith in Jesus. The week prior to camp another father joined us with his children and wife. After the message he too responded to the Gospel.

We had a beautiful moment after our lesson where he shared with everyone briefly his testimony. He'd tell us how he was saved by Jesus and was trying to make his life right before the Lord. He'd been clean from drugs and alcohol for three months and he was working on his sobriety.

He was in a major accident at work where he should have died but God preserved his life. This young father, by the grace of God, joined us at camp with his children and wife. He has a long road ahead of him but what a joy it's been to see how the goodness of God has transformed his heart.

Our focus is the children but through the children God allows us to reach the parent(s). One of the children came up to me as we were preparing to leave for camp, "Pastor Nick! Pastor Nick!" They said, "I want to show you something."

Out of their pocket they took out this beautiful hand drawn picture of Jesus with scriptures around it. They were so excited about Jesus; what He'd been doing in their life, what He was about to do. I can only imagine how much influence the transformation of this one child's heart has had within their home.

The children of the father who came, responded, and shared his testimony had come to our program regularly for months. Every week we knocked on their door and months passed where we had never seen the father. The week he came was the first week I had met him.

God was working all of it together in preparation of this one day where the father would come with his children and in turn give his life to Jesus. These are the moments that make everything we do, all the sacrifices, that most people don't even see, worthwhile. These moments of glory compel us to move forward in reaching more children for Jesus.
