Sidewalk Sunday School



The Mission of Christ

In addition to our primary site, we've been serving children and families at another apartment complex nearby. There's not a single person I've met yet who speaks English. Recently five children from the community attended our Sunday School program.

Not even one of them spoke English. As someone who doesn't speak Spanish this can be discouraging. Nevertheless, we show up every week, we teach our lesson, and we trust the Lord. The Bible says in Isaiah 55:11 God's Word will not return void, and it will accomplish what He purposes.

Where I see a void (the language barrier) God sees an opportunity. Every week God sends exactly who and what we need to accomplish the work He's sent us out to do. One of our volunteers, fluent in Spanish, sat with those five children that day translating the message.

By the grace of God, at the end of the lesson, all five of those precious children raised their hands in response to the Gospel. Every one of them confessed their sin and entered into a relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. Joy filled my heart. As I was discouraged God encouraged me.

Jesus in one statement summed up the purpose of His entire life and ministry. Miracles took place, people were healed, demons were cast out, and sermons were preached. These were wonderful things, but nothing mattered more than one thing. Seeing lost people saved.

Jesus came to earth on a mission to seek lost sinners. He came to save them from death. Not a physical death but a spiritual death. Sinners couldn't be saved from the condemnation of sin without the Son's intervention. Jesus came to intervene in order that all people had opportunity to be saved.

Jesus took upon Himself the sin of the world and died the death we deserved. The wrath of God would be fulfilled and through Jesus we have been rescued and redeemed. Jesus mission was a rescue operation that was complete when He rose from the dead defeating death, sin, and the devil.

The mission of Christ was to seek and to save the lost. This was the purpose of His entire life and ministry. One person saved mattered more to Jesus than thousands of people who heard Him preach. Heaven rejoices when even one sinner repents and turns to God. How beautiful it is that we get to share in Christ's mission through the Church.

Seeing those five children raise their hands in response to the Gospel made every minute of what we do worthwhile. God used this to remind me that regardless of whatever barriers or obstacles are before us we must continue to persevere. We must continue to show up and lead as many children to Jesus in the community as we can.
