The World is a Battlefield

Throughout the fall we've been learning about the Armor of God. Every day, though we may forget at times, we face a spiritual war and an enemy who is real. Our adversary, the devil, walks around like a roaring lion, seeking for someone to devour (1 Peter 5:8).

Satan's primary priority is to bring defeat. His only desire is to steal, to kill, and to destroy. Whether we want to believe it or not the world is a battlefield. God wants us to be prepared for the battle at hand. Therefore, He gives us armor to protect us. Armor which we must pick up, put on, and wear with confidence.

God has given us His Word and the Spirit which provide the wisdom and protection we need to stand firm against the enemy. Important to emphasize are the first few words of the memory verses. "Be strong in the Lord and in His might power."

When we go into the community to serve, we enter into a battlefield. Drugs, addiction, destruction, gangs — they plague the community. Families are still displaced by hurricanes this year that severely damaged buildings in the complex. Parents are going to prison; families with children are being evicted.

In Matthew 8 Jesus is on a boat with His disciples. A fierce storm brews on the lake. The disciples are afraid for their lives. Jesus is calm and in fact He's asleep. The disciples cry out, "Lord save us!" Jesus responds, "Why are you afraid? You don't have enough faith." With a word Jesus calmed the storm.

Jesus instantaneously provides hope, peace, and comfort for our lives in the middle of the storm. The battle has been won; the storm has been calmed. Strength is secure, provision has been made, hope is eternal, and peace is promised. Pick up the full armor of God, put it on, and wear it with confidence

In Christ there's no reason anymore to be anxious, afraid, doubtful, or discouraged by what's happening in us or around us. Praise the Lord that this is the message of hope we are privileged to share on battlefield which God has called us to wage war against the enemy.
