WHAT IS REPENTANCE?

Repentance means to change your mind. It goes beyond just feeling sorry or remorseful. It is a change of mind and heart. It leads to a change in action and direction. True repentance aligns us with God's will.





TO WHOM ARE WE REPENTING?

We are repenting to God, the Creator of all things:

- He made us in His image and likeness.
- He gave us tremendous value and purpose.
- Repentance restores our relationship with our holy and loving Creator.

OF WHAT ARE WE REPENTING?

We are repenting of:

- Sin any thought or action that falls short of God's will.
- Unbelief in Jesus Christ rejecting the truth of who He is and what He has done.

Sin means to "miss the mark" of God's perfect moral standard.



WHY MUST WE REPENT?



Repentance brings us into agreement with God:

- Repentance shows humility and submission to God's moral standard.
- When we repent and believe in Jesus, God gives us His Holy Spirit:
 - We receive new life.
 - We are empowered to live in a way that pleases God.
 - His Spirit is a guarantee of eternal life.

HOW DOES REPENTANCE & RECONCILIATION BEGIN?

It begins with the gospel. The good news of what God has done through Jesus Christ.



THE GOSPEL STORY

God Created All Things

- God created the heavens, earth, seas, and all creatures.
- He made humanity, male and female, in His image.
- He gave us a divine mission:
 - Be fruitful and multiply.
 - Steward creation.
 - Exercise dominion over it.
- He generously provided and gave one command: "Do not eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil."



Humanity's Condition

- Every human is born with a sinful nature.
- We are naturally inclined to rebel against God.
- A day of righteous judgment is coming:
 - "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God." (Romans 3:23)
 - "The wages of sin is death..." (Romans 6:23)
- God is holy. He hates sin and must judge it.




The Invitation of Salvation

- Jesus is now exalted at the right hand of the Father.
- "There is no other name under heaven by which we must be saved." (Acts 4:12)
- He became sin for us, so that we might become the righteousness of God (2 Corinthians 5:21).

 - We are promised eternal life

The Fall of Man





- Sin entered the world through this disobedience.
- As a result:
 - Humanity lost innocence.
 - Creation was corrupted.
 - Death and separation from God began.

Eternal Judgment or Eternal Life



- "It is appointed for man to die once, and after that comes judgment." (Hebrews 9:27)

 - Those who receive Him will enjoy eternal life and peace with God.
