IMPORTANT NOTICE

EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2025 2025 WASTE COLLECTION SCHEDULE

TO: OTTAWA STREET - GLADSTONE TO WINDERMERE

GARBAGE COLLECTION - Please see attached schedule

Your garbage collection does not change during holiday weeks.

 Place GARBAGE out for collection only on <u>MONDAY & THURSDAY NIGHT</u> prior to <u>10:00 P.M</u>. Please <u>DO NOT</u> put garbage out on any other day. All Garbage must be in an acceptable container.

Acceptable Containers:

METAL OR PLASTIC PAILS

- Maximum 125L
- Maximum weight 20kg / 45lbs.
- Garbage must be placed in a bag within the container.

ROLL - OUT CARTS

- Must have a lower bar configuration 18" from the ground and an upper lift attachment that is 33" from the ground.
- Capacity limit 363L / 96gal.
- Garbage must be placed in a bag within the cart.

DO NOT put **Cardboard** and other **Recyclables** out with your GARBAGE.

RECYCLING COLLECTION - Please see attached schedule

- **RECYCLABLES** will be collected biweekly <u>at the curb</u> according to the attached schedule.
- Use Blue/Red Boxes or Blue Recycling Carts for large quantities of recyclables.
- Ensure RECYCLABLES are secure and will not blow around the neighborhood.

EXTRA CARDBOARD COLLECTION - Please see attached schedule

- If you produce large amounts of CARDBOARD, place out <u>at the curb</u> each <u>WEDNESDAY NIGHT</u> prior to 10:00 P.M. for Wednesday night collection. This collection does not change during Holiday weeks.
- <u>CARDBOARD PREPARATION</u>: Please break down all cardboard boxes and secure in bundles or place in a large box that does not exceed 48" x 48" and weighs less than 20 kg/45lbs.
 Cardboard is recyclable and should <u>NEVER</u> be placed out for <u>GARBAGE</u> collection.

In addition, remember that the Public Drop off Depot located at North Service Road & Central Ave is open Monday through Saturday for the self disposal of GARBAGE, RECYCLABLES & YARD WASTE.
