Description:

The applicant is requesting a DA permit to discharge 2,112.3 cubic yards of clean fill and dredge 1,570.9 cubic yards of material to construct a four-lane elevated viaduct along SR 414 between US 441 and SR 434 and widen SR 414 from four to six lanes. The proposed activity will result in 5.80 total acres of impacts to aquatic resources, which includes 2.09 acres of direct impacts to jurisdictional forested mixed wetlands (Wetland 1 and Wetland 2) and 3.71 acres of impacts to non-wetland surface waters. The purpose of the project is to provide additional transportation capacity to accommodate the growing area and improve regional connectivity between SR 429 and I-4 to meet future traffic needs.

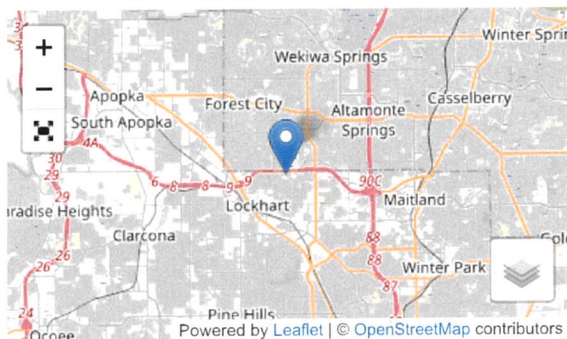
