Lap swim undecided at the moment, we can only get 25 people in there, we will start off the week taking reservations and will see what the numbers are.

There is a 90-minute block for swim, then 30 minutes to clean. This is pretty much the guidelines from the state and the county. You need to call the pool at 530-644-9674 to make reservations.

I am hoping if people do not feel well, they stay home. If we get one case of Covid we have to close the pools. We are not providing any pool toys, or games in the cabana, only the pools and bathrooms. No BBQ inside the pool, if you want to BBQ you can use the recreation area at your own risk.

Bob- members only, no guests. Call during the pool hours from 9:30am to 7:30 pm to make reservations for the next 1-2 days.
